

Re: Warren County November 2023 Location Plan

Dear State Board of Elections Members and Staff:

On Wednesday, August 2, 2023 during a special called meeting, the Warren County Board of Elections voted unanimously to accept the enclosed voting plan for the November 2023 election. Warren County plans to utilize five (5) early vote locations and 12 election day centers. This plan is the same as May 2023, but with the addition of State Street Baptist Church as a new election day only location. Both early and election day locations will be countywide vote centers.

Warren County currently has 91,867 registered voters. We are planning for a turnout of 50% (approximately 46,000 voters) which is higher than the anticipated turnout for November. We used each location's turnout for the last three elections to help determine estimated November 2023 turnout. We are confident all 12 locations will be fully equipped and staffed to handle the maximum number of voters expected at each facility.

We will continue to preprint ballots but will also utilize multiple Verity Print on Demands at each location. The enclosed spreadsheet outlines our daily allocation of equipment and officers for each location. We will ensure parity among all poll workers across all locations.

Included is a labeled map of locations, and an example of how we set up our countywide vote centers. Our board is working with county and city government to coordinate free rides to the polls on Election Day. We are currently working with local non-profit organizations to map out diverse pickup locations throughout the city that will take voters who need transportation to nearby

polling locations. We plan to utilize the county-owned trolley to make this happen.

Warren County government is also working to form a taskforce between community members and government officials with a goal of raising awareness of voting options in Warren County. We believe informational handouts and community forums will increase turnout in all our communities. This will be combined with our previous outreach of advertising on social media, in newspapers, and on television. All information is also available on our website at warren.countyclerk.us.


Since the change to the vote center model Warren County has been very successful in streamlining the voting process. We have seen shorter wait times around the county and increased our level of customer service for all voters. Our ability to have staff involvement in setting up and running these vote centers has provided a great deal of consistency across all locations. Citizens of Warren County are getting accustomed to the vote center model and the convenience that comes with the ability to vote at any location over a period of four days. We hope legislators see the positive affect vote centers have on our communities and continue to support this model in the future.



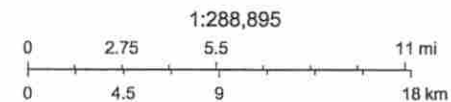

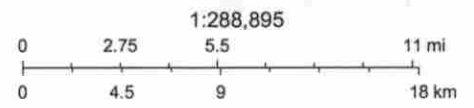

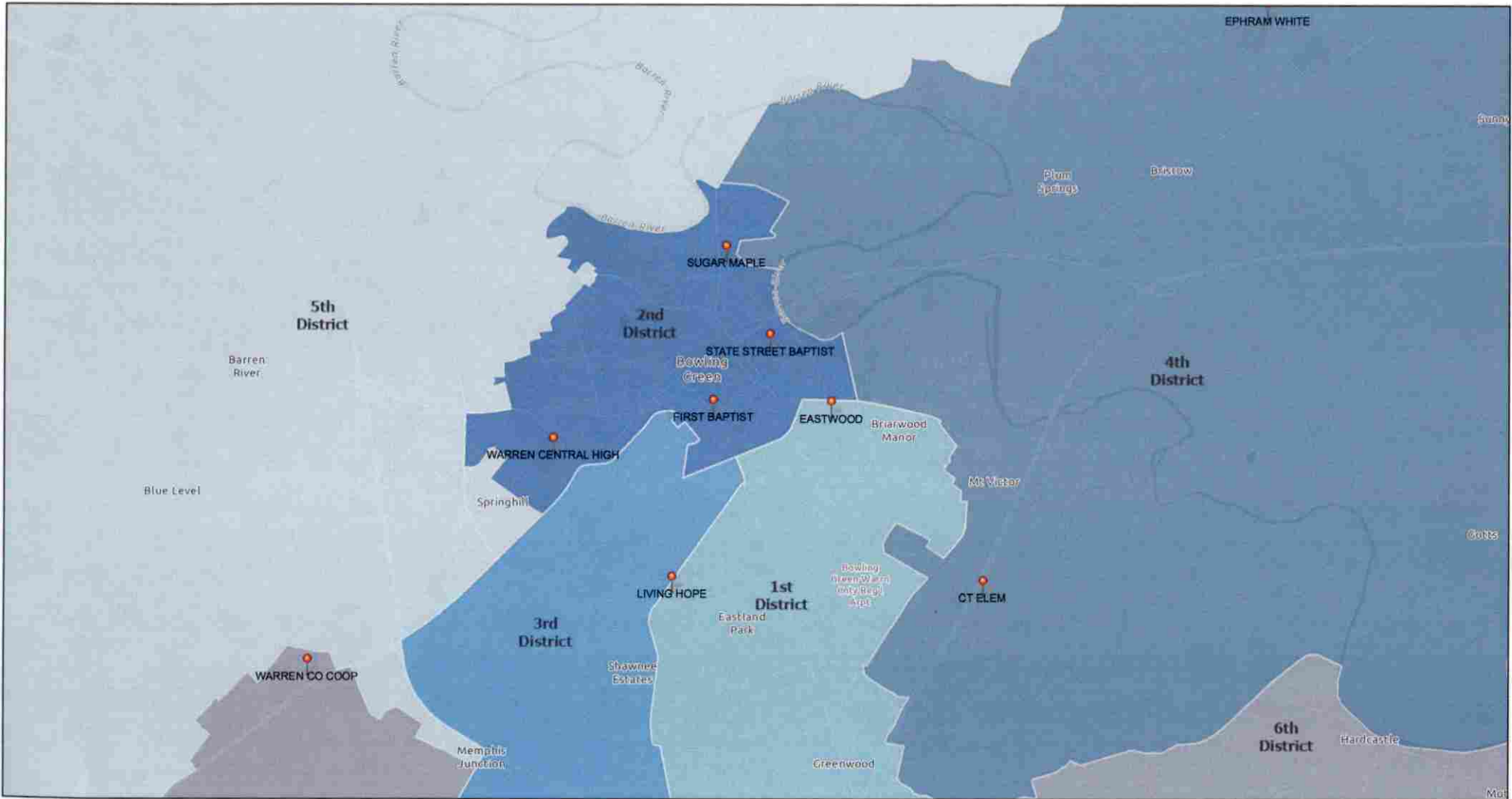

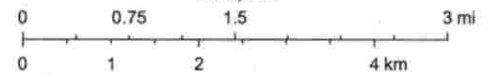
