4.) How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community?

This proposed consolidation of precincts is the exact plan Woodford County utilized for the elections in 2020, 2022, and the Primary of 2023. The entire process of having a voting center at Falling Springs Recreation Center was extremely well-received by the voters. Based on there being absolutely no problems with long lines that would affect the efficiency and speed of their voting experience, the replication of the clearly defined plan that was used in previous elections at the Falling Springs Voting Center, which is centrally located in the middle of the county, is respectfully requested for consideration.

The Woodford County Board of Elections received a huge amount of positive feedback from voters on Election Day while voting at Falling Springs Recreation Center and weeks after the election. The plan for In-Person Voting for this facility that has 3 basketball courts, is to only use one court that will provide 4 voting machines and 40 voting booths for In-Person/Early Voting. With four (4) clerks available to sign in voters on the E-Poll Book with a 45 second to 1 minute check in time, any delay to move a voter through to receive their ballot and cast their vote would be minimal to none.

2) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?

With four (4) stations available, there will be a Clerk, a Democratic Judge, and a Republican Judge at each station. There is no need to have a Sheriff assigned to each station; however, there will be two (2) Sheriffs assigned to oversee the needs all four (4) stations.


3) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a "Vote Center?"

First and foremost, all Precinct Election Officers who witnessed the positive voting experience at the "Falling Springs Voting Center" while serving during previous elections is the most accurate and valuable form of publicity. They would not only be announcing the location, but they are able to attest as a first-hand witness how the voting process was efficient at Falling Springs. The Precinct Election Officers can also verify the fact parking was definitely not an issue. Not only was there ample parking, but three (3) golf carts were in the parking lot ready to move voters with mobility issues from their parking space to the front door and back to their car after voting. Additionally, a wheelchair is ready and accessible for any voter who needs assistance getting from the curbside handicap parking space to the front door. Of course, the normal forms of advertising would be used such as our local newspaper, social media, and signage. This location would be noted as the "Falling Springs Voting Center."

4) How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community??

The Falling Springs Recreation Center is the focal point of our entire community. If you are familiar with the center and the County Park here in Woodford County, you know this facility is used by all ages with the theater, pools, basketball courts, fitness center, numerous ball fields, soccer stadium/football stadium, fairgrounds, etc.

The location of this center, which serves as the pivotal, essential hub of our community, is located in the center of the county as evidenced by the map attached. As shown on Attachment A, a Voting Center at the Falling Springs Recreation Center is more than reasonably accessible to all voters and can allow 90 voters to vote at one time.

This proposed consolidation of precincts is the voting plan Woodford County utilized for the elections in 2020, 2022, and the Primary of 2023. The reason voters in Woodford County prefer the entire process of having a consolidated voting center at Falling Springs Recreation Center is because there are absolutely no problems with long lines that would affect the efficiency and speed of their voting experience. The replication of this consolidated voting center that was used in previous elections at the Falling Springs Voting Center, which is centrally located in the middle of the county, is respectfully requested for consideration.

The Woodford County Board of Elections received a huge amount of positive feedback from voters on Election Day while voting at Falling Springs Recreation Center and weeks after the election. The plan for Election Day Voting for this facility is to use two (2) basketball courts that will provide 8 voting machines and 80 voting booths. There are nine (9) total clerks available to sign in voters on the E-Poll Book, which includes a check-in station in the multi-purpose room located close to the front door. This accessibility and efficient speed in which to voter is checked in to vote with a 45 second to 1 minute check in time is another reason voters in Woodford County prefer a consolidated voting center over the precinct voting process.

2) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?

With nine (9) stations available, there will be a Clerk, a Democratic Judge, and a Republican Judge at each station. There is no need to have a Sheriff assigned to each station; however, there will be seven (7) Sheriffs assigned to oversee the needs all nine (9) stations, which includes total coverage from the front of the voting center to all voting stations.

3) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a "Vote Center?"



2) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?



2) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?


With 1 station available, there will be a Clerk, a Democratic Judge, a Republican Judge and a Sheriff at the 1 station.
