UPDATE TO THE ORIGINAL LETTER: AS OF 1/30/24, BULLITT COUNTY HAS ONLY ONE (1) CANDIDATE FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE 26TH HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES RACE, PEYTON GRIFFEE.

WE BELIEVE THAT THE PLAN SUBMITTED BY DEADLINE IS SUFFICIENT.

The plan is to utilize the Ridgway Memorial Library building for this Special Election. The building is closed and empty of all library inventory except the furniture and shelving. The lights, heat, and bathrooms are all in working order.

The north end of the county is less than a 10-minute drive to Shepherdsville. There is a divided 4 lane road, with a 55-mph limit.

We are confident this one location is sufficient for the expected voter turnout. The bulk of the voters are inside a 6-mile radius from the library building.

A105 is rural. There is not a convenience store in the precinct to the best of my knowledge.

B111 is the ONLY precinct in Mt. Washington and there is not a road from B111 to C109. They are separated by Floyds Fork stream.

C109 is not a densely populated precinct, though large in square miles.

D101 is in the southern tip of the county and has direct access to KY State Road Hwy 61 & I-65, north and southbound.

Pre-Pandemic we were able to handle 2500+ voters in a single school building location for Election Day voting without issues. We never had more than 4 precincts in a school gym Pre-Pandemic.

This Special Election will have 5 voter check in stations, in addition to the use of EPB's w/thermal printers that greatly increase the speed of voter check-in. I see no reason we cannot do the similar volume given the 4 days of 3 Day Early voting and Election Day.

If the situation demands it, we can put up to 5 more EPB'S at the existing 5 voter check-in stations. This will provide 10 voter check-in locations. The plan is to set up 20 ballot marking tables, and 2 Verity Scan devices.

The November General Election, a county wide election, had 5 check-in stations in the north-end. The voter turnout in the north-end was 3317, EV/ED combined. 5 check-in stations in the north-end are comparable to 5 in the Ridgway Library.
