Hello Gentleman,

In preparing for the November General Election, my County Board of Elections met last Thursday and approved the following proposal. We are requesting four (4) voting locations in the County, one at the First Baptist Church in Junction City, one at Perryville Baptist Church, one at Boyle County Fire Department Station 1 in the Danville City Limits and one at First Christian Church in the Danville City Limits. We can accommodate a total of 7 voting groups within all the locations and maintain social distancing safely. We will have a total of 44 precinct officers with 28 actually working the polls and the other 16 doing temperature checks, handing out PPE and directing voters to the appropriate lines. There will be a minimum of 12 epoll books and 16 Escan machines.

For absentee voting, we will have two (2) locations. One will be at the Courthouse and one will be at the National Guard Armory. Voting at the Courthouse will be conducted Monday – Friday during normal business hours and three (3) Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Voting at the Armory will have varied hours, Monday hours will be 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m. and Tuesday – Friday 8:00 a.m to 4:00 p.m. We will have 2 escan machines and 10 poll workers at the Armory. Office staff and 1 part time person will handle the office voting.

The Armory will be available if any of the other locations become unavailable on Election Day.

The Boyle County Board of elections requests approval of the above proposal for absentee and Election Day voting. Thanking you in advance for your consideration.
