NARRATIVE EXPLANATION OF COUNTY PLAN:

My plan for the November 3, 2020 Election is to use the Conference Center in the General Butler State Park. The address is: 1608 Hwy 227, Carrollton, KY 41008.

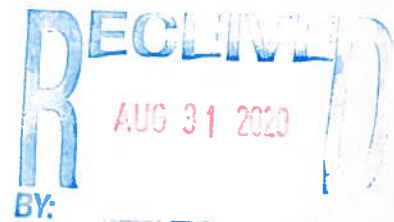
We used this building for the June Primary and it worked beautifully. I understand the recommendation is to have more than one voting location, but this location is centrally located in our county and is in compliance with the current CDC regulations.

Under the current guidelines, the building is able to accommodate 200 people at one time. I will have 3 e-poll book stations for people to sign in at when they come through the front door. Once they have signed in they will go into a large room where I will have the Touch Writer along paper ballots. They will go to any one of the 6 Precincts that I will have set up, be given a ballot, ink pen and a "I Voted Sticker". There will be 24 - 6 ft tables with security screens at each end of the table therefore being able to vote 48 people at one time. Once they have completed their ballot, they will go to any of the 11 scanners setup along the back of the room, scan their ballot and will exit out a different door separate from the front entrance doors.

There is also a separate covered entrance for anyone that is needing handicapped assistance.

While I understand this is not the recommendation, I would hope you would consider approving this plan. If I have to open limited precincts in my county I do not have any other place that would be able to handle the amount of people that would go through there at one time. Also, opening some of my other precincts would only confuse my voters because they would not understand why some are open and some are not. To be able to tell everyone to go to one place on Election Day would be much less confusing for my voters.
