Narrative Explanation of County Plan:

Because of slow, unreliable or non-existent broadband outside of the city limits of Marion the county seat and where one-third of the county's 6,700 voters reside — the inablity of electronic poll books to communicate with one another in order to prevent double voting is an issue with offering polling in outlying communities that traditionally host precinct balloting. The voting super center at Marion Ed-Tech Center would offer separate rooms for voting — one for city voters and one for rural voters — with two machines in each. This would make it faster for poll workers to process voters by reducing possible ballot faces to five for city voters and six for rural voters. The facility offers ample parking, full handicap accessibility, open space for distancing, men's and women's restrooms, seating for waiting voters and is only one mile from the courthouse. It also offers a kitchenette for the comfort of poll workers. As a safety valve, also utilizing the courthouse as an open precinct would offer a voting station with the county clerk's staff nearby or help resolve voting issues. Recommended precautions to limit the potential spread of COVID-19 will be used.
