**Narrative Explanation of County Plan:**

We will have six locations for early voting that will also serve on Election Day. All will be county-wide voting centers. It should be noted that this is logistically the only locations available to us that meet ADA and parking requirements, and can be trusted as secure locations for overnight storage of machines and ballots. Schools are not available and churches are not secure, which removes the vast majority of our normal locations.

In addition, the civic center is unavailable due to construction. The football stadium cannot be used for early voting due to SEC football. We have partnered with literally the only remaining locations that meet our needs, and that are available and willing to serve.

Fayette will once again use our warehouse for all Ballot Processing Committee actions. It will be livestreamed by local government when in session, and there will be a designated area for observers.

Six Ballot drop boxes will be deployed geographically, all under security cameras. The boxes we have purchased are already used in Colorado and will be bolted to concrete securely. They are made by Kingsley, and we are using Type C 30" boxes.

This plan's max capacity is an 85% turnout where 30% vote in-person.
