SBE will take county plans as soon as you have them, but they must be turned in no later than **September 30**.

These locations do not need to be approved, but the emergency regulations require that SBE and SOS help counties publicize the early voting locations. By completing this form and returning it, you make this possible. Please return this form as soon as you can, but not later than **October 12** (the day before early voting is to begin).
