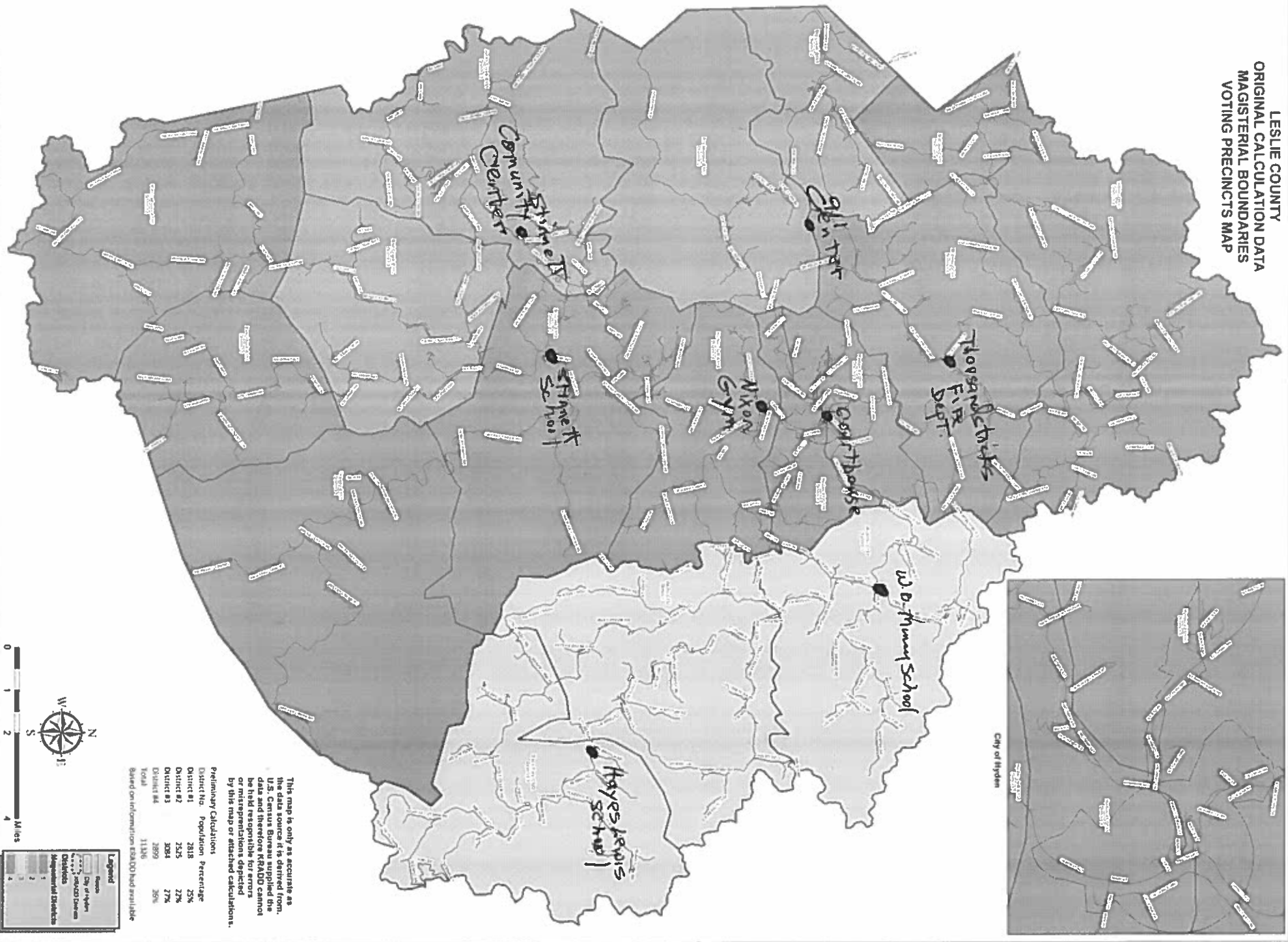




Election Board Meeting Agenda


September 11, 2020
