

Old National Guard Armory/ Rec Center behind Post Office

190 South Winter St Russellville KY 42276

October 13-Nov 2, 9am-4pm Monday-Friday and (3) Saturdays leading up to Election Day 9am- 1pm

8 Poll workers needed for this process at pay rate of 12.00 per hour estimated cost (936hrs=11,232.00)

Two clerks for check in, two ballot judges, one machine judge, one sheriff, and two cleaning floaters (All made up with party parity)

This Voting Center will have 25 privacy standup booths and 1 Handicap turntable that can vote four for 29 people voting at one time. There will be two scanners in this location and one Handicap access machine. This facility will also serve as Center on Election Day November 3 from 6am-6pm, at a cost for eight poll workers at \$200 for the day for a total of \$1600.

Old Historic Courthouse 200 West 4th St Russellville KY 42276

This facility will serve as a second Voting Center for Election Day November 3 6am-6pm


It will consist of four clerks for check in, two ballot judges, three machine judges, one sheriff, and two cleaning floaters

This Voting Center will have 21 voting standup booths and 1 handicap standup with 4 for 25 voting capability at once with three scanners and one handicap access machine. On Election Day, we will pay the 200 per worker for estimated cost of (2400.00) for Election Day

Processing Committee for mail in process consisting of four people of party parity and needed from September 21 – November 3 from 8am-4pm (7hrs per day) hour for lunch for 896 hrs. @12 per hour = 10752.00 which the State Board of Election is supposed to give Clerks Office another Cares Grant for 14560.00. With Fiscal Courts acknowledgement of the same process as in Primary Election County Clerk will deposit and expend this money to workers in processing committee. Clerk will be responsible for all Audit and SEFA reports to DLG for these funds. Any excess funds will be turned over to Fiscal Court in next Fee Report.

Counting Committee will be made up of four citizens of party parity, County Board Members and will be called in and paid 12 per hour by fiscal court as needed for counting process through Election Day.



Hello to Governor Beshear, Secretary Adams, KY State Board of Elections and State Board Members,

Logan County Board of Election met Friday August 21 and discussed the Regulation presented to us last Thursday August 20 and the enclosed plan has been approved. The Fiscal Court Meeting today approved this plan with the financial infrastructure needed to hire poll workers for all jobs. As Clerk, I want to stress that all of this that has been talked about in the regulation and has been taken in account for every voter to have ample time to vote in this Election. Logan County has a very tough ballot that in 20 precincts has worked for years, but when you do any type of Voting Centers, it would be very difficult to add any more locations for logistics and cost.
