Dear All,

I am writing on behalf of the Kenton County Board of Elections about a timing conflict and approval process conflict I am not sure how to resolve.

- 1. August 9: County Boards are required to provide the State Board of Elections with an Election Day plan by August 9, 2023.
- 2. September 20: KRS 117.065(1) gives the County Board of Elections up to September 20th to establish polling locations.
- 3. September 20: The County Board has a consent agreement with the DOJ that means they must approve polling locations and they have up to September 20th to do it.

The County Board will submit all necessary documents for review to the SBE by August 9, 2023. However, the Board is requesting either a conditional approval pending the approval of the locations by DOJ or a deferral of the SBE's review pending the decisions of the Department of Justice (DOJ).

Drop Boxes- four (4) drop boxes located in two locations.

Inside & outside at Kenton Co Gov't Center, 1840 Simon Kenton Way, Cov. Inside & outside at Historic Independence Courthouse, 5272 Madison Pike, Ind.

Precincts- There are 70 precincts with the State Races but there are three (3) unexpired school board races and one (1) unexpired city council race which means there will be 72 ballot faces.

Early Voting Locations- Five (5) early voting locations that will function as voting centers which allows a voter to go to any location to receive their precinct specific ballot. This is accomplished with using a Ballot on Demand printing system as well as the ES&S Express Vote. The Express Vote is essentially a ballot on demand system that has all the precinct specific ballots available.

Election Day Locations- In 2020 Kenton County had twenty-four locations and then added ten more location for the 2023 Primary for a total of thirty-four (34) locations.

Based on requests for additional polling locations, the Board has approved four (4) additional locations. This would increase the number of locations to thirty-eight (38).

Fiscal Court will be purchasing additional scanners, Express Vote printers, e-poll books, e-poll book printers and tables to accommodate these additional locations. This also means an increase in the necessary supplies, signs, training dates, training costs etc...

Hopefully the executive committees of the Democratic and Republican parties will be able to provide additional poll workers to man these additional locations.

Board's basic rule for manning each location is as follows:

Two (2) judges per location

Two (2) sheriffs per location

One (1) clerk per thousand assigned voters with a two (2) clerk minimum.

Due to the DOJ agreement, the Board is required to have Election Day Surveyors (EDS) to review all the locations for 6-days of voting, three (3) days of early voting and the 38 locations on Election Day. We had four (4) EDS for 2023 Primary but with the increase in locations, we will likely have to add two (2) EDS. These people are paid for the day as well as their mileage.

Board's basic rule for equipment for each location is as follows.

One E-poll book and printer per clerk assigned to the location.

One (1) DS200 scanner per 4,000 assigned voters since that is their ballot capacity.

One (1) Express per thousand assigned voters.

Not sure how many parking spots are considered sufficient.

Past, current, and future polling locations must be reviewed by the Department of Justice (DOJ). Once there is approval by the DOJ, these locations can be:

- 1. Added to the location roster for Kenton County
- 2. Surveys can be added to SOS website.
- 3. Surveys can be added to the VRS.
- 4. Voter can be updated in VRS on their assigned polling location.
- 5. Voters can be notified as to their new assigned polling location.

Election day locations are listed as consolidated locations per definition of the SBE but they are in fact VOTING CENTERS. Kenton County assigns precincts to specific locations in case a voter wants a pre-printed ballot, but the voter can choose to go to any location on Election Day as long as they are willing to use the Express Vote. The Express Vote is programed with all possible ballot styes and the DS200 is programmed to accept all possible ballot styles. The five early voting centers with the Ballot on Demand also are available on Election Day and this helps give voters more choices.

This Election Plan gives all voters, especially those with accessibility issues, more flexibility to choose the location most convenient for them. It also ensures that if a voter goes to the wrong location, or has moved, we do not have to redirect them to a different physical location.

In addition to the submitted plan, the County Board will be submitting some precinct modifications as requested by the City of Covington and approved by the County Board. There is also a precinct modification due to the reapportionment passed by the Fiscal Court on July 25, 2023. I hope that a swift review and approval of these changes can be achieved.
