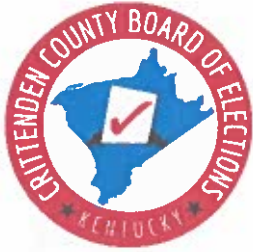

The 2024 General Election Plan submitted on behalf of Crittenden County Board of Elections is essentially the same as for the primary in May, except that we will be adding a second clerk for Early Voting and at the Mexico Baptist Church voting location on Election Day due to expected high turnout. Additionally, we will be placing a supervisor in the form of staff or seasoned poll worker at all locations to ensure forms are completed properly and all questions can be answered as efficiently as possible.

One caveat is the availability of reliable connectivity at our Shady Grove Fire Volunteer Department voting location in remote eastern Crittenden County that serves voters of F101. Connectivity has been unreliable over the last few elections at this, our smallest voting precinct, despite utilizing a cradle point to boost signal.

Unless the fire department or county government can produce some type of reliable internet signal, when the Board of Elections next meets on July 12, we will make the decision to remove the Shady Grove voting precinct and allow those voters to cast a ballot at our Countywide Voting Center or at Repton Baptist Church, which already serves as home to neighboring A101 voters.

This will impact fewer than 200 voters (149 voted in the last gubernatorial election, 54 in the May primary) but ensure integrity that a lack of connectivity could compromise.

If this occurs, an amended election plan for the general election will be promptly submitted for your consideration.
