

Dear All,

I am writing on behalf of the Kenton County Board of Elections for review and approval of an amended 2024 General Election Plan. The County Board is submitting all necessary documents for review to the SBE. The initial plan was submitted on July 8, 2024, and the County Board reserved the right to amend the plan due to potential ownership changes and other DOJ review feedback,

Since the State Board of Elections approved the original plan, there have been locations changes that the County Board feels are necessary due to the safety and welfare of voters. Some of the location's changes are also per the request of the DOJ.

The following locations are having to be relocated and attached are the updated: 1. County Election Planning Report. 2. SBE 74 OF LOCATION

1. Ft Wright Civic Club to Ft Wright Elementary

Reason for relocation: This location has been one of the locations that the DOJ wanted relocated since the original survey of the location in 2020. In January of 2024, this location was gifted to the City of Ft Wright. The City had an engineering company do a site review to determine the condition of the building. The report listed black mold and various ADA compliance issues. This information was posted in the local paper and many comments were received about how terrible it was that it was a polling location. After speaking with the City Administrator, she also disclosed that the roof has a leak that won't be fixed before the election and there is no hot water. She couldn't say how bad the mold might get since the leak was not to be fixed prior to the election. She also stated that the bathrooms were not ADA compliant.

After providing this information to the board, we felt we could not in good conscience have poll workers work in such conditions for over 12 hours or expose them to black mold. Also, the board did not want to expose any voter to these conditions and the potential health threat of black mold.

The board voted to move this location to Ft Wright Elementary School. A new ADA survey is being submitted to the DOJ for their review and approval.

2. School House Bees to Ryland Heights Elementary

Reason for relocation: This location was added in 2023 and has been used twice. The assigned precinct is Morningview. It originally replaced the Kenton Baptist Church that was removed by the DOJ because it did not meet any of the ADA compliance requirements for voting. School House Bees is a private business that creates honey for sale, and they have over 30 hives on the property. The hives are located very close to the building.

During the 2024 Primary, there were complaints filed by voters and County Clerk staff that the bees were swarming. Some people were trapped in their cars while the bees were swarming. One of my staff members is highly allergic to bees and refused to get out of the car since she wasn't carrying her EpiPen on her.

After presenting these concerns to the County Board, the board discussed the possibility of the bees swarming in cooler weather and the potential health issues if a voter was stung. The board felt we could not in good conscience keep this location.

This is a very rural area, and other locations were considered (St. Mathews Church, a private retreat center) but they do not meet the required ADA standards. There are few buildings in this area. The board voted to move this location to Ryland Heights Elementary school which is already an existing location. The distance between School House Bees and the school is four (4) miles.

The board voted to move this location to Ryland Heights Elementary School.

3. Emerald Springs Clubhouse and Crescent Springs City Building to new Crescent Springs Fire House

Reason for relocation; The City of Crescent Springs is one precinct, but they were voting in two separate locations because the Crescent Springs City Building was considered a problem by the DOJ because it lacked ADA compliance, and the voting area was very small. It also created issues with privacy and the heavy carpeting made it difficult for wheelchairs. In 2023, the board tried to remediate the issues with the city building by adding the Emerald Springs Clubhouse. However, the DOJ did not like the Clubhouse and found that it also did not meet the requirements.

The Crescent Springs Fire House is a new facility finished in August of 2024. It has over 40 parking spaces, additional 12 new handicap parking spots, and a large training room that can be used for voting.

The board voted to combine and move these two locations to Crescent Springs Fire House. A new ADA survey is being submitted to the DOJ for their review and approval.


Election Day Locations-If the State Board accepts these changes and approves this amended plan, then the number of locations is only reduced by two locations for a total of thirty-six (36) polling locations however, there is an additional location specifically to handle large crowds, which is the NKY Convention Center. This additional location gives voters 6 early voting locations and 37 Election Day locations.

The County Board feels that Kenton County's voting plan gives all voters, especially those with accessibility issues, more flexibility to choose the location most convenient for them. This flexibility gives the voters chose to go to a location closet to their house or their work. It also ensures that if a voter goes to the wrong location, or has moved, we do not have to redirect them to a different physical location.

Once approval is received, then any other documents requiring modification can be done. For example, the updated location map and excel spreadsheet.

If the State Board decides to not approve this amendment, I would ask that we be contacted as soon as possible.

I am writing on behalf of the Kenton County Board of Elections for review and approval of the 2024 General Election Plan.

The County Board is submitting all necessary documents for review to the SBE. All the polling location information that is being submitted is still subject to review and approval of the DOJ's remediation plan. The County Board voted unanimously for approval of the plan on July 1, 2024.

Drop Boxes- four (4) drop boxes located in two locations.

Inside & outside at Kenton Co Gov't Center, 1840 Simon Kenton Way, Cov.

Inside & outside at Historic Independence Courthouse, 5272 Madison Pike, Ind.

Precincts- There are 72 precincts. This ballot will include:

Two Constitutional amendments

US Representative

State Senator for odd years

This will result in 108 different ballot faces.

Early Voting Locations- There are six (6) early voting locations that function as voting centers. The Northern Kentucky Convention Center was added just for this Presidential Election and will function as a true voting center for Early Voting and Election Day using the Express Vote and the Ballot on Demand Systems. This location will not be used in the future unless needed.

Voting centers allow a voter to go to any location to receive their precinct specific ballot. This is accomplished with using a Ballot on Demand printing system as well as the ES&S Express Vote. The Express Vote is essentially a ballot on demand system that has all the precinct specific ballots available.

Election Day Locations- There are thirty-eight (38) polling locations. Election day locations are listed as consolidated locations per definition of the SBE but are actually VOTING CENTERS.

Kenton County assigns precincts to specific locations for distribution of pre-printed ballots, but a voter can go to any location on Election Day as long as they are willing to use the Express Vote. The Express Vote is programed with all possible ballot styes and the DS200 is programmed to accept all possible ballot styles.

The six (6) early voting centers with the Ballot on Demand also are available on Election Day.

This Election Plan gives all voters, especially those with accessibility issues, more flexibility to choose the location most convenient for them. It also ensures that if a voter goes to the wrong location, or has moved, we do not have to redirect them to a different physical location.

There has not been a change in the locations, but there are several that have changed ownership since the primary and we have not had confirmation that they can be used for the General Election. The Board reserves the right to amend the plan pending the change or addition of a polling location.

Board's basic rule for manning each location is as follows:

- Two (2) judges per location

- Two (2) sheriffs per location

- One (1) clerk per thousand assigned voters with a two (2) clerk minimum.

For the 2024 General, the Board would like to add additional clerks to decrease any potential lines based on an expected higher volume of voters.

Due to the DOJ agreement, the Board is required to have Election Day Surveyors (EDS) to review all the locations for 6-days of voting, three (3) days of early voting and the 38 locations on Election Day. We have four (4) EDS for 2024 General. These people are paid for the day as well as their mileage.

Board's basic rule for equipment for each location is as follows.

One E-poll book and printer per clerk assigned to the location.

One (1) DS200 scanner per 4,000 assigned voters since that is their ballot capacity.

One (1) Express per thousand assigned voters.

Not sure how many parking spots are considered sufficient.

Past, current, and future polling locations must be reviewed by the Department of Justice (DOJ).

Once there is approval by the DOJ, these locations can be:

1. Added to the location roster for Kenton County
2. Surveys can be added to SOS website.
3. Surveys can be added to the VRS.
4. Voter can be updated in VRS on their assigned polling location.
5. Voters can be notified as to their new assigned polling location.
