To Whom it May Concern:

Madison County will continue to have the same consolidated precinct election plan for the 2024 General Election as it did for the 2024 Primary Election.

- This includes the same drop box locations at both Clerk Office Branches
 - Richmond Branch at 231 N. Madison Ave. Richmond, KY
 - Berea Branch at 304 Chestnut St. Berea, KY
- The same location of the 6-Day Excused In-Person Absentee Voting location at the Richmond Clerk's Office at 231 N. Madison Ave. Richmond, KY
- The 3-Day No-Excuse In-Person Absentee Voting will be at the same locations, with the addition of 2 more locations.

Based on experience, proximity, and availability. Will have 6-10 workers with party parity

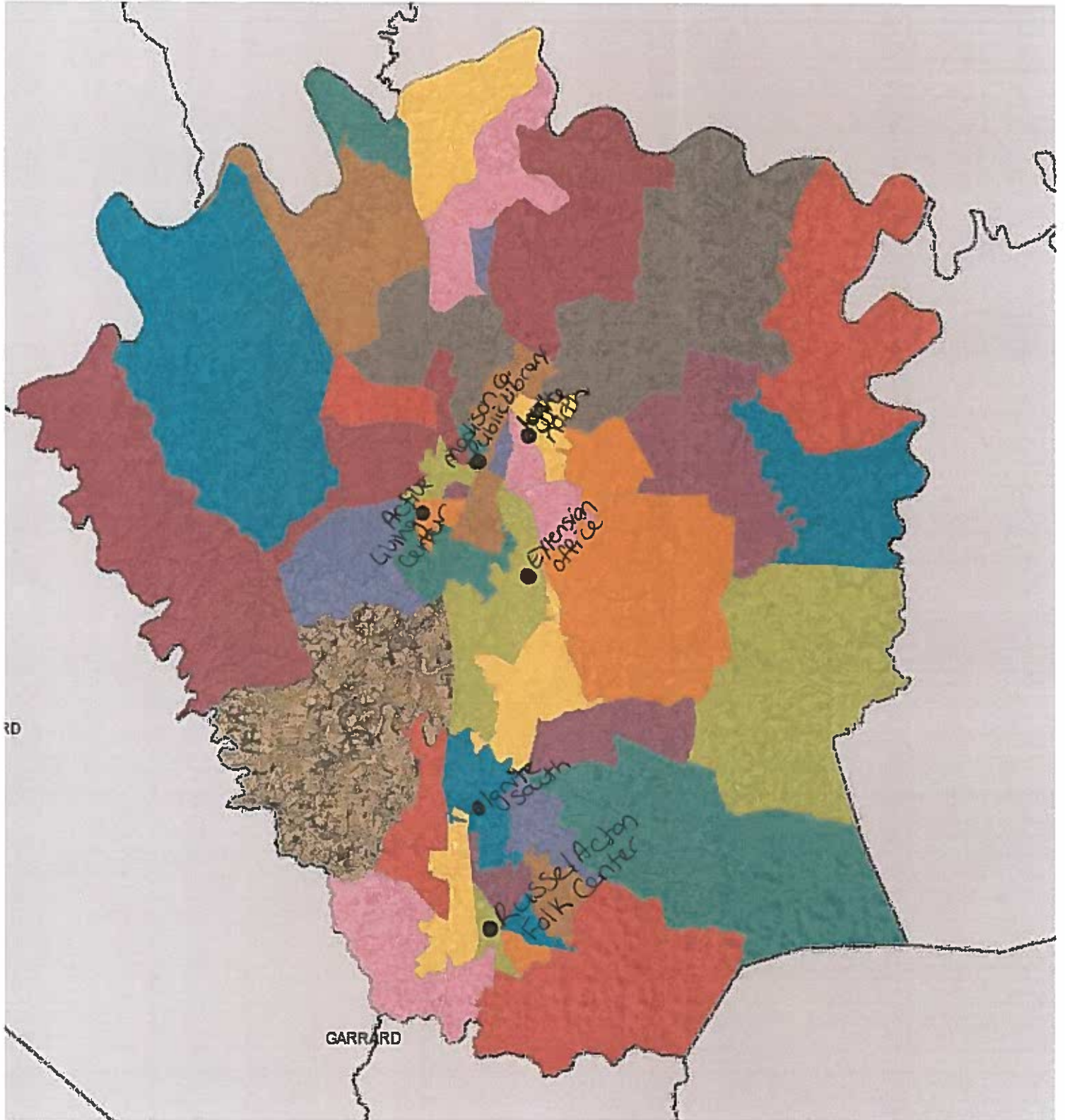
3.) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a "Vote Center?"
