To the Honorable Members of the State Board of Elections:

The Marion County Board of Elections voted this morning to amend our 2024 General Election Plan.

The Election Day plan will remain the same. All 12 Election Day polling locations will remain open as true Vote Centers for any registered Marion County voter.

The three day Early voting plan has changed. Previously, the plan stated that Early Voting would be held from 8:20am – 4:20pm at the David R. Hourigan Building. The Marion County Board of Elections has voted to move the location for Early Voting to the Marion County Public Library. The hours have been extended to 8:00am – 8:00pm.

Attached, you will find a listing of our polling locations for all four phases of the election calendar and SBE 74s for each of our polling locations.

We humbly ask that you consider and approve this amended Election Plan for the 2024 General Election.


