1. Calloway County will have eight (8) Vote Centers consisting of the following:
 - a. University Church of Christ (new vote center; not previously used)
 - b. North Elementary (previously used)
 - c. Southwest Elementary (previously used)
 - d. Elm Grove Baptist Church (previously used)
 - e. New Concord Church of Christ (previously used)
 - f. Hazel Baptist Church (previously used)
 - g. Kirksey Baptist Church (previously used)
 - h. Murray High School (previously used)
2. Calloway County has used the CFSB Center in the past as a vote center. This location will not be available for the 2026 Primary Election due to renovations. The County Board voted to use the University Church of Christ as a replacement voting center. This location is on the same road as the CFSB Center so it is a convenient location and has adequate parking and space.
3. EPoll Station: each location will utilize 2-4 check in stations
4. Print on Demand Ballot Printers: Each location will utilize 2-4 print on demand units, with back up paper ballots in the event of a power loss/printer malfunction.
5. Voting Booths: each location will have 10-20 voting stations
6. Ballot Scanners: each location will have 2-3 ballot scanners
7. ADA Machine: each location will have 1 ADA voting machine
8. Precinct officers: each location will have 6-10 precinct officers
9. Absentee Voting (excused 6 day; in person): Excused in person absentee voting will be held in the Clerk's office
10. Early Voting (no excuse, 3 day): Early Voting will be held at the Courthouse Annex located at 201 S 4th St Murray, KY 42071. This space has been utilized for this purpose for early voting since the 2020 Election Cycle.
