The information below explains the separation of precincts in Greenup County, as well as the voting machines used at each location:

Greenup County has fifteen precincts located throughout the county at convenient and accessible sites, including fire departments, church fellowship halls, and school districts. In addition, we also have one vote center located at the Greenup County Courthouse. All precinct locations are handicap accessible, and provide adequate parking and spacious voting areas to comfortably accommodate the voters.

During the 2022 Primary Election, the Greenup County Board of Elections made the decision to combine precincts due to the shortage of poll workers. This decision was made cautiously, combining only precincts that were located within a few miles of one other to ensure voters they could continue to vote close to their home. This plan was approved and has continued to be used successfully. There have been no complaints regarding these adjustments, and the voting lines have consistently moved quickly and efficiently with the assistance of our poll workers.

As a result of the plan changes implemented in 2022, Greenup County reduced the number of voting locations from 29 to 16, including the vote center reflected in the new precinct numbers. Currently, the county has six single precinct locations, primarily in more rural areas; four locations that serve two precincts, five locations that serve three precincts, and one vote center open to all voters.

Each single precinct location is equipped with one verity scan machine and one verity duo. Locations serving more than one precinct is equipped with two verity scan machines and one verity duo to ensure efficient voter processing.

A map has been attached to help illustrate precinct boundaries and locations. The precincts that appear more spread out on the map are single precinct locations which is located in rural areas of the county. These locations serve a smaller number of registered voters, ranging from approximately 700 to 1,100 voters. However, the areas with the greatest concentration of precincts correspond to where the majority of the county's population resides, including the cities. These precincts range from 1,400 voters to 3,800 registered voters.

This plan has been used successfully during county and presidential elections with high voter turnout. All elections have proceeded smoothly, with no complaints reported.
