Johnson Counties Election Plan for the Primary Election, May 19, 2026, is the same plan use for the General 2024 Election. This plan places the Vote Centers out geographically so the voters will be covered in all areas of the county. Using Vote Centers has worked very well in past Elections and the Voters are well pleased with using this voting method.

Schools and Government Buildings are good choices for many reasons. There is no cost to the Fiscal Court for rental of the use of the facilities. There is access highspeed internet for the use of Poll Books. Parking is ample and voters have proper handicap accessibility. The building is fully ADA compliant. The polling location provides larger areas for voter to social distance and provides perfect conditions for any types of weather.

Having voting centers are well received by the voters and they like being able to go to any Vote Center to cast their ballot. Having Vote Centers provide voters that are assigned to the wrong precinct or voters that have failed to change their address to be assigned to the correct precinct without leaving that location. This reduces the number of Election Officers needed for Elections.

Having limited Early Voting has been a challenge. Every effort to inform the Voters of the dates and time times to take advantage of early voting. I use the local newspaper, radio and social media to push out the information. The three day no excuse voting is always many voters, this helps reduce the crowds on Election Day.

The Voting Equipment used by Johnson County is ES&S voting equipment and we are very pleased with the products they provide. The equipment is very user friendly to Election Officers and Voters alike, while provide the confidence of Election Security that is the most crucial aspect of the Election. The Secure Election Drop Box is in the Lobby of the Johnson County Clerk's Office it is convenient and secure.

The Johnson County Board of Elections goal is to ensure Fair and Honest Elections with making sure that every Voter that has the right to vote do so with confidence.

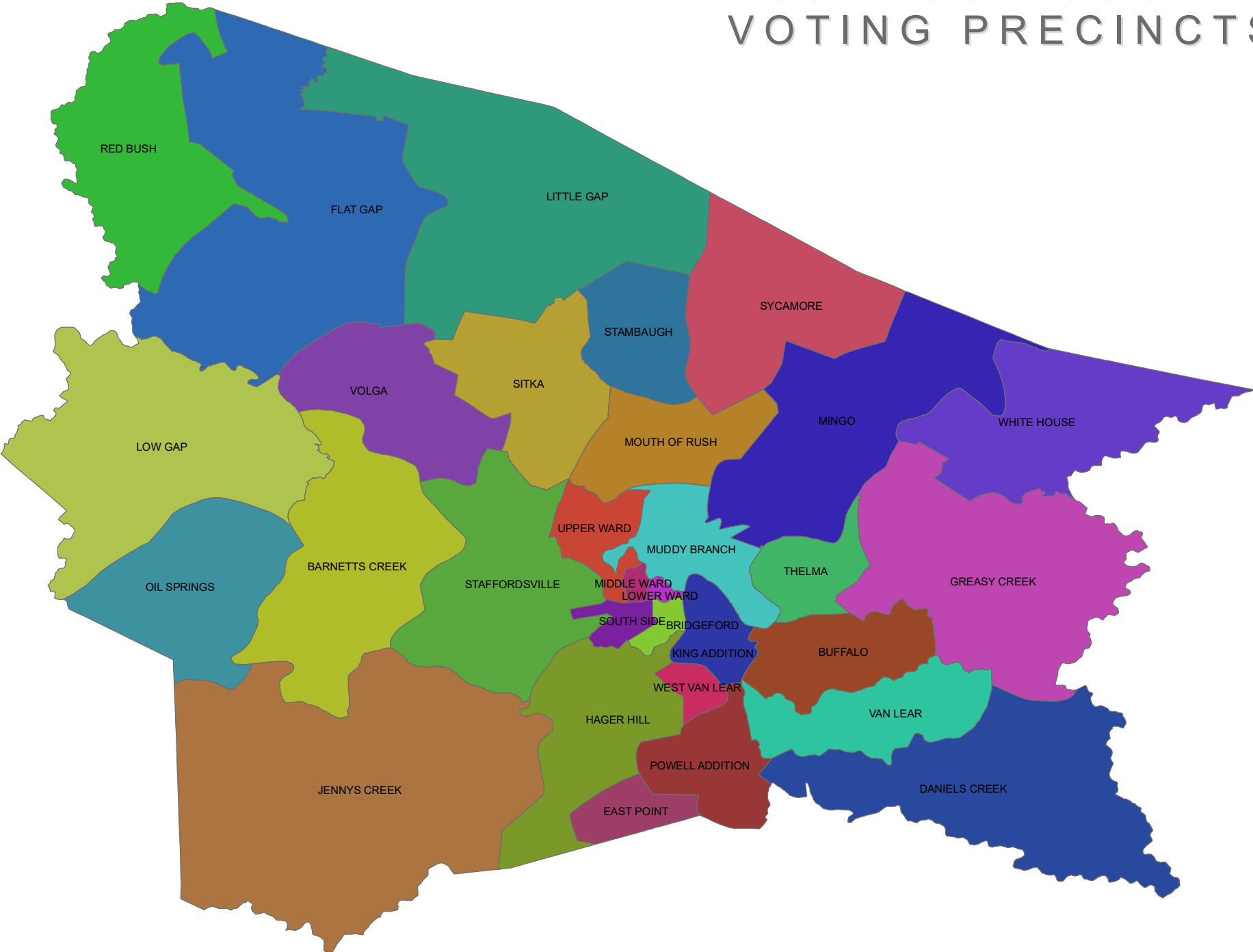
