Marion County Election Plan – 2026 Primary Election

To the Honorable Members of the State Board of Elections:

The Marion County Board of Elections has approved our 2026 Primary Election Plan.

The Election Day plan will remain the same as previous years. All 12 Election Day polling locations will be open as true Vote Centers for any registered Marion County voter. A map of those locations is attached.

The 6 day In-Person Absentee voting location will continue to be conducted at the County Clerk Office by the County Clerk Office staff.

The three day Early voting plan is similar to our 2024 General Election Plan. Early Voting will be conducted off-site at a location that provides better parking and access for voters. In the 2024 General Election, the Early Voting was conducted at the Marion County Public Library. For the 2026 Primary Election, voters will have the opportunity to cast their ballot at the Marion County Event Center and Sportsplex for the extended hours of 8:00am – 8:00pm each day.

Below, you will find a listing of our polling locations for all four phases of the election calendar, SBE 74s for each of our polling locations, and a map showing each of the Election Day polling locations.
