Adair County Clerk Lisa Greer called the meeting to order.

APPROVAL OF JANUARY 27, 2022 MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

Motion to approve minutes as presented by Sheriff Brockman, second by Vickie Pike, the vote was unanimous for approval

DECISION ON AMENDING VOTING LOCATIONS DUE TO LACK OF WORKERS:

The clerk had sent press releases to the local newspapers, radio stations, online magazine, fiscal court Facebook, asking for poll workers, had a few respond.

The clerk also contacted Superintendent Stephens, to see if she would send out a email to her staff asking for poll workers, Vickie Pike had talked to member of high school site base council, and they were bringing it up at their meeting that student who were registered and be 18 by November General could work. Vickie also spent numerous hours contacting our regular poll workers. With all this being done we were afraid by May we may be short some workers. Therefore the following motion was made by Clerk Greer, to help alleviate at least around 8 or 9 workers. By consolidation of these three voting locations no precincts would be changed just one set of workers could take care of both precincts at each location, and machines would be set for those two precincts only.
