It is still located in the City County Building in Scottsville, Ky it has just been moved from the second floor to the third floor. This change was made to allow more room for the election officers and voters.

\*The drop box will be located in the Allen County Clerk's Office, 201 West Main Street Room 6, Scottsville, KY 42164. Our hours are Monday-Friday 8am-4:30 pm and Saturday 8am-12pm.

\*The 6-Day Excused In-Person Absentee Voting will be located in the Allen County Clerk's Office, 201 West Main Street Room 6, Scottsville, KY 42164. Our hours are Monday-Friday 8am-4:30 pm and Saturday 8am-12pm.

\*The 3-Day No-Excuse In-Person Absentee Voting will be located on the third floor of the City County Building, 201 W Main Street, Scottsville, KY 42164. The hours will be 8am-4pm Thursday-Saturday.

\*We have seven vote centers in Allen County on Election Day. Any registered voter can go to any of the seven locations and vote. The vote centers are located at the following:
