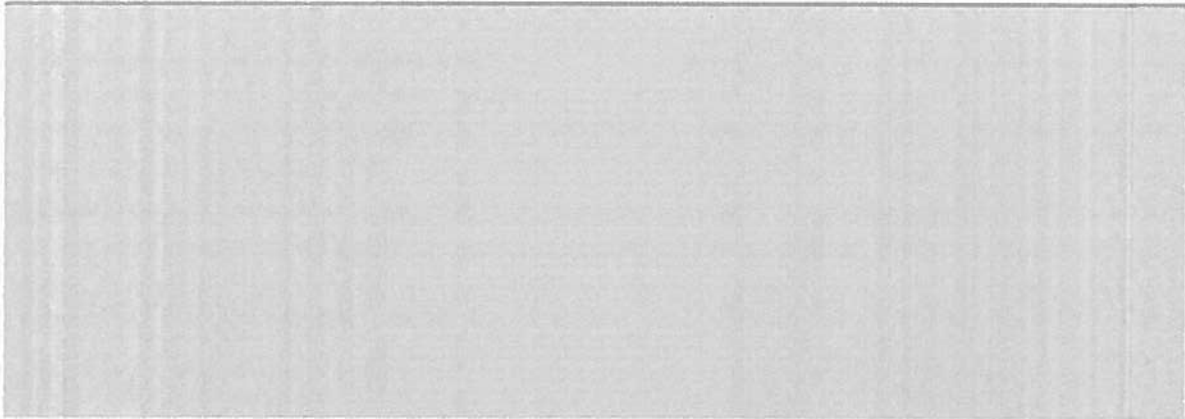

 - large location - plenty parking - ADA compliant.



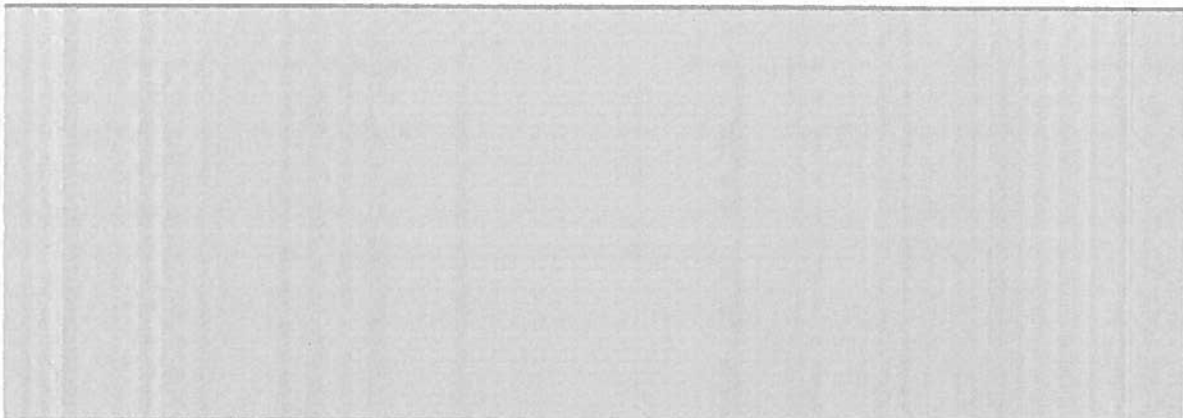
