1.) Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable? <input type="checkbox"/> This is the same plan used in the last election
The three days of early voting can be adequately served in the new county office complex, which offers ADA accessibility, adequate on-site parking and room for social distancing, all three unlike the previous courthouse. Early voting would be held in the fiscal court room, which is near the front of the facility with direct access from two public entrances.
2.) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned? <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> This location will be fully staffed with election officials
Early voting will be staffed by a traditional complement of poll workers (balance of parties with clerk, sheriff and opposite party judges).
3.) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a "Vote Center?"
Local newspaper and radio station multiple times from now until the election. Facebook. Clerk and county website. Signs posted in office and county office complex. "Early Voting" signage.
4.) How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community?
The county office complex is the geographic center of the community, and for the first time, access to county offices and is fully ADA-compliant. This site was used as the 2020 general election countywide voting center with zero complaints or issues with accessibility or delays in voting. It also offers a kitchenette for poll workers and direct access to the county clerk's office for voter registration questions.

1.) Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable?

This is the same plan used in the last election

As with consolidated precincts, it offers the county a lower cost for voting equipment and poll workers. It offers an ideal way to vote for all six precincts that traditionally voted within a 1-mile radius at separate locations in the City of Marion, MBC Family Life Center is one block from the downtown centers, offers more-than-adequate parking, is ADA accessible and has updated facilities. For rural voters who work in the city, it is also ideal. +

2.) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?

This location will be fully staffed with election officials

As a county-wide voting center, three full-sets of poll workers would be used. Six rural precincts are covered with voting locations in their geographic area. This plan was used in both 2022 elections with zero complaints or issues with accessibility or delays in voting.

3.) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a "Vote Center?"

Local newspaper and radio station multiple times from now until the election. Facebook. Clerk and county website. Flyers posted in office and courthouse. "Voting Center" signage onsite. +

4.) How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community?

MBC Family Life Center is in the literal center of the county and City of Marion, where virtually all services and retail offerings and the daily workforce in the county are located. It is within walking distance for most of the disadvantaged in the city who live in low-income or elderly housing. It offers complete ADA accessibility, multiple entry-exit options, scores of off-street parking spots, a covered entrance and plenty of room for social distancing. It also offers a kitchenette for poll workers. +

It puts all voters from Magisterial District 2 together, continuing to offer a polling location without voters having to drive outside their geographic area. Deer Creek Baptist Church, a longtime polling location for B101, has more-than-adequate parking, is ADA accessible and has updated facilities as opposed to the polling location historically used by B102 voters. It also lies dead-center of the district. +

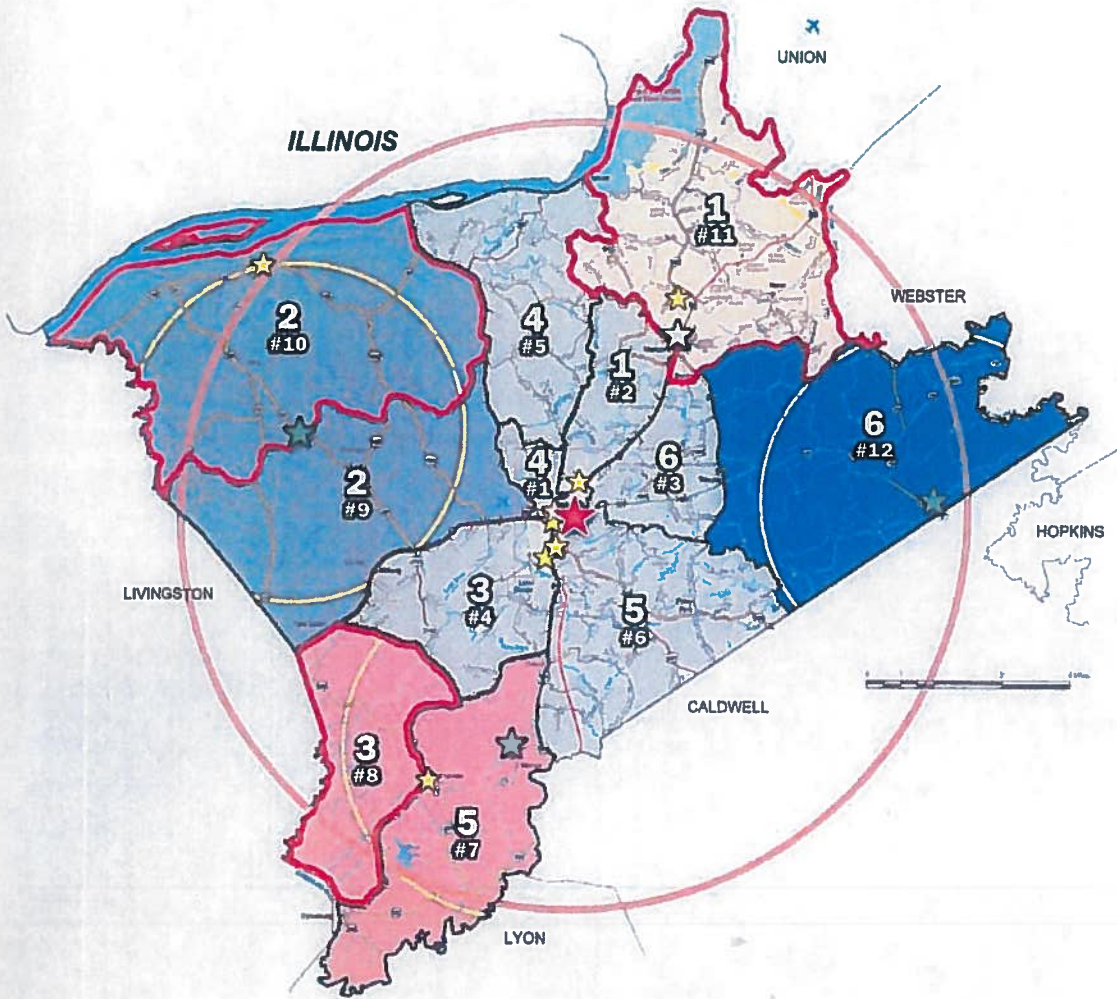
