2022 Daviess County Election Plan (9/7/2021)

All Ballots:

All ballots will be setup for "Precinct/Other Code" during General Elections and "Party/Precinct/Other Code" during Primary Elections; this will allow for statistical data to be gathered for candidates, political parties, and researchers.

Mail-In Absentee Voting:

In anticipation for this type of voting to return to a slightly higher rate than what we had in previous elections, we will ask that during the peak period of mail-in absentee voting (4 weeks out from a primary and 6 weeks out from a general election) that Fiscal Court add one Republican and one Democrat temporary worker to our team. They will assist the Election Department with answering phones, taking requests for mail-in ballots, assisting in preparing the ballots and sending these ballots out, along with tracking and receiving them back. The Board of Elections, depending on the volume of mail-in absentee ballots, may use these 2 individuals to finish the process.

Of course, the mail-in ballots will be used for individuals who meet the required specific reasons for requesting a mail-in absentee ballot. We also will be able to utilize the portal and the label tracking system to keep up with what goes out and comes back in. As ballots are returned, the Election Department staff will inspect signatures: if the signature can be easily verified, it will be "accepted"; if it can't be determined, the ballot will be sent to the Board for review. The Board (with assistance if necessary) will begin opening, processing, and scanning ballots at the earliest time allowed by law.

In-House Absentee Balloting:

Awaiting law clarification: We anticipate holding this in Room 107 of the Courthouse as was done in the past. Again, this will be dependent on a law correction. This will be available to individuals who meet the specific requirements to vote by in-house absentee.

Early Voting:

We would like to hold this "no excuse" early voting during the hours of 7:00AM to 6:00PM on the Thursday and Friday prior to Election Day and 8:00AM to 1:00PM on the Saturday before the Election in three (3) dedicated locations (Preferably at the Owensboro Sportscenter, Owensboro Christian Church, and Life Community Church). This would provide 27 hours of early voting where anyone can vote prior to Election Day in three different locations. We will setup six (6) check-in stations and enough support staff to handle voters over the course of the 3 days. We will staff these locations with up to 54

workers total per day each managed by one coordinator from our office per location. At least one individual will be stationed at the Clerk's Office to address issues while these sites are active. At the locations, we will have a computer that will allow the manager to have access to the voter registration system for searches and problem solving issues as well.

Election Day:

On Election Day, we plan to have initially 15 voting centers where anyone in the County can choose a voting location that is convenient for them. To make this possible, we will have a predetermined amount of ballots for all precincts and styles for the entire County printed and distributed to each location; in addition, we will purchase ballot on demand printing devices for each center as a backup (the designated Center Manager will be solely responsible for operating the ballot on demand system). All ballots will be setup for "Precinct/Other Code" during General Elections and "Party/Precinct/Other Code" during Primary Elections; this will allow for statistical data to be gathered for candidates, political parties, and researchers.

At each voting center, we will station a predetermined amount of Epollbook Check-in Stations based on estimated turnout in a given area (at first, we will over-staff until we get a good feel for turnout). Each location will be equipped with one ballot printing device, at least 2 ballot marking devices (ADA compliant), and at least 2 scanning devices initially. As time progresses, it will be our recommendation to consistently add additional ballot marking devices to each center annually. In addition to the equipment, we will train a member of our office to be the manager of the location for the day.

Flow: Voters will enter and be directed to a line by a que-line attendant (who is responsible for making sure the line moves smoothly at check-in). They will then progress to an epollbook check-in station where they will present their IDs, sign the epollbook, and be issued a slip with their precinct and other code. If they have an issue or need ADA assistance, they will be sent to a customer service table where their issues will be addressed (this will be the area where the ADA machines will be available as well)-ALL ISSUES AND ADA VOTING WILL BE HANDLED IN THIS AREA. From there all voters without issues or who need no assistance will go directly behind the check-in area to one of the judges' tables to receive their ballots and then go to an open booth to complete said ballot. After that, they will finish the process by depositing their ballot in one of the scanners as they exit the building. There will be a linear flow to each of our voting centers.

End of the Night:

At the end of the night, our manager will be responsible for collecting devices for results, making sure that all equipment is secure and broken down as best as possible, as well as making sure the summary results are posted on the designated area of the building. This individual will make sure that all proper documentation is completed and that result devices (MBBs/USB sticks) are securely placed in their proper envelope(s) and sealed. Over the sealed back, one Republican and one Democrat must sign across the sealed area and place the date and time of which they are signing saying that the envelope has all of the proper results and devices inside. The manage will then sign and place the date and time across the back just as the other two. That manager will then deliver that package to the County Board of Elections. Upon receipt of the package, the Republican and Democrat will sign and date the envelope before passing it off to the IT staff that will open the envelopes and remove the result devices for tallying. These results will be loaded onto a local website and uploaded to the State at the end of the night.
