Franklin County Voting Plan 2023

The Franklin County Clerk's Office will be using the same plan that was used for the 2022 General Election. All previous 12 county wide vote center locations utilized in the 2022 General Election will remain the same for 2023 elections. We will be adding additional print on demands, scanners, poll pads, and precinct workers at the most populated vote centers. This will avoid congested voting by allowing more voters to check in and vote simultaneously.

- On the 3rd floor, Fiscal Court, 315 W. Main Street, Absentee Mail in balloting will be processed by a committee with bi-partisan appointment from the Franklin County Board of Elections. The official ballot drop box will be located under surveillance at the main office in the lobby, 315 W. Main Street, from April 3rd, 8:00 A.M. through May 16th, 6 P.M. (M-F).
- All 6-Day Excused In-Person Absentee Voting will be located at the Franklin County Clerk's Office, 315 W. Main St. on the 2nd floor, handled by the Clerk's Election Staff and designees.
 - Wednesday, May 3rd through Friday, May 5th and Monday, May 8th through Wednesday, May 10th (8:00 A.M. until 4:30 P.M.).
- All 3-Day No Excuse In-Person locations will be the same as it was in the General Election of 2022:
 - Thursday, May 11th and Friday, May 12th (8 A.M.-6 P.M.)
 - Saturday, May 13th (6 A.M.-2 P.M.)
 - Eastside location: Capital City Christian Church
 - Downtown location: Yes Arts (former Frankfort Plant Board Building)
 - Westside location: Capital City Activity Center (senior center)

This early voting plan worked perfectly last year and gave equal opportunity to all Franklin County voters.

All voting methods will be advertised through the local paper for the Primary Election and direct mail, social media, and the local paper for the General Election.

Franklin County voted at 50% of eligible voters in the 2022 election with very few issues. The adjustment and changes should allow for 95% of eligible voters for future in person Election Day. With the additional equipment added, we can vote approximately 40,000 voters through Early Voting and Election Day.



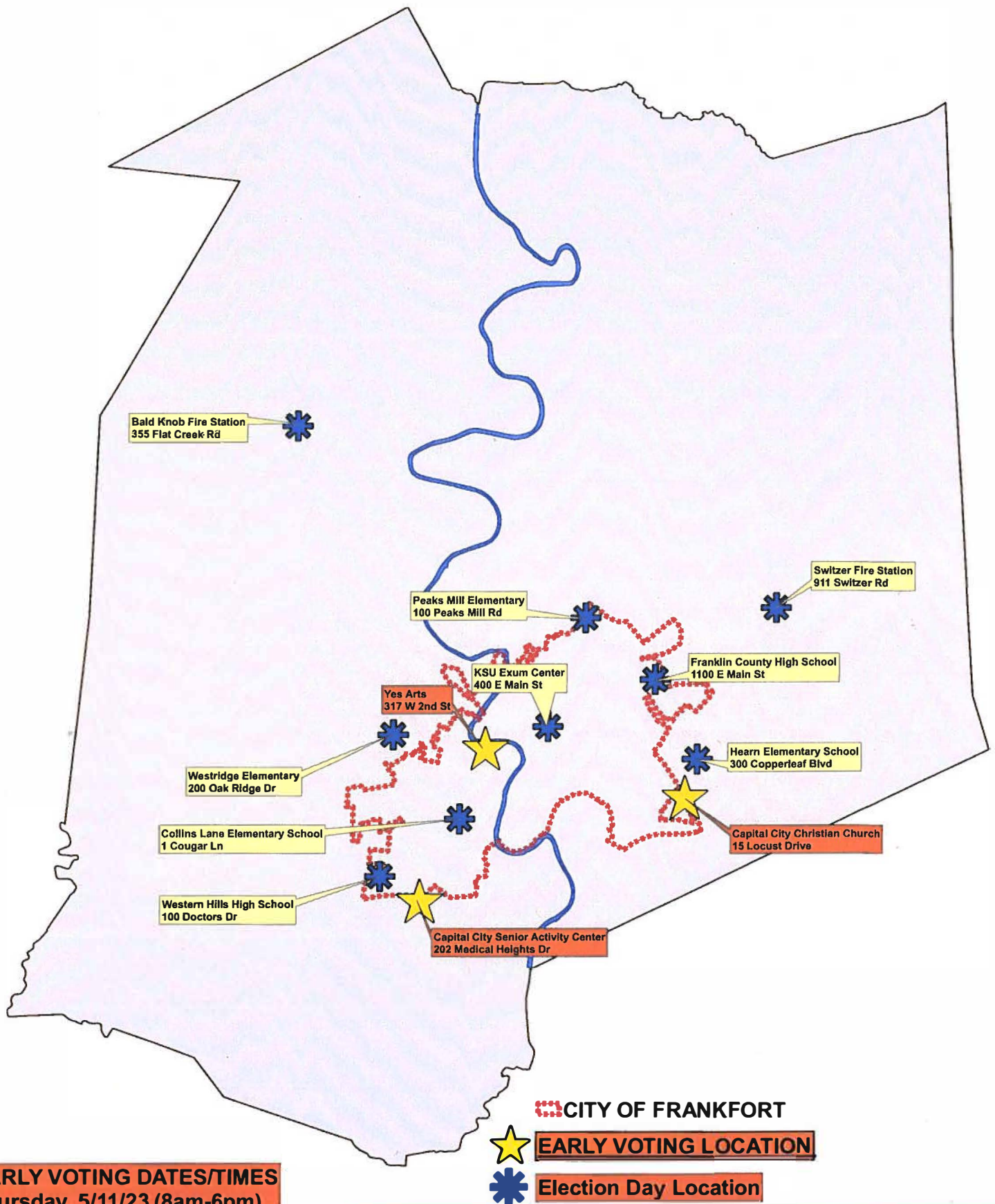
