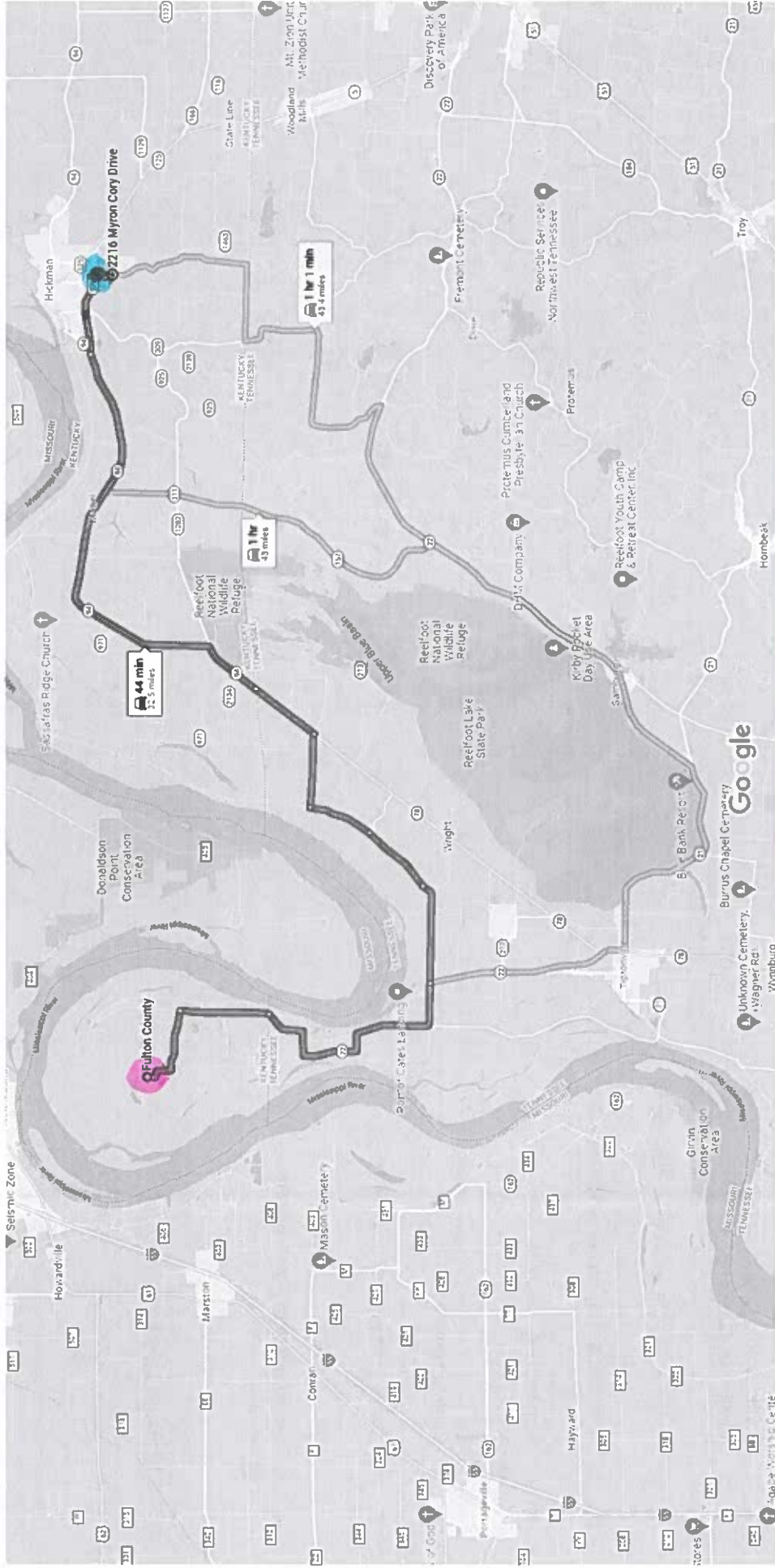

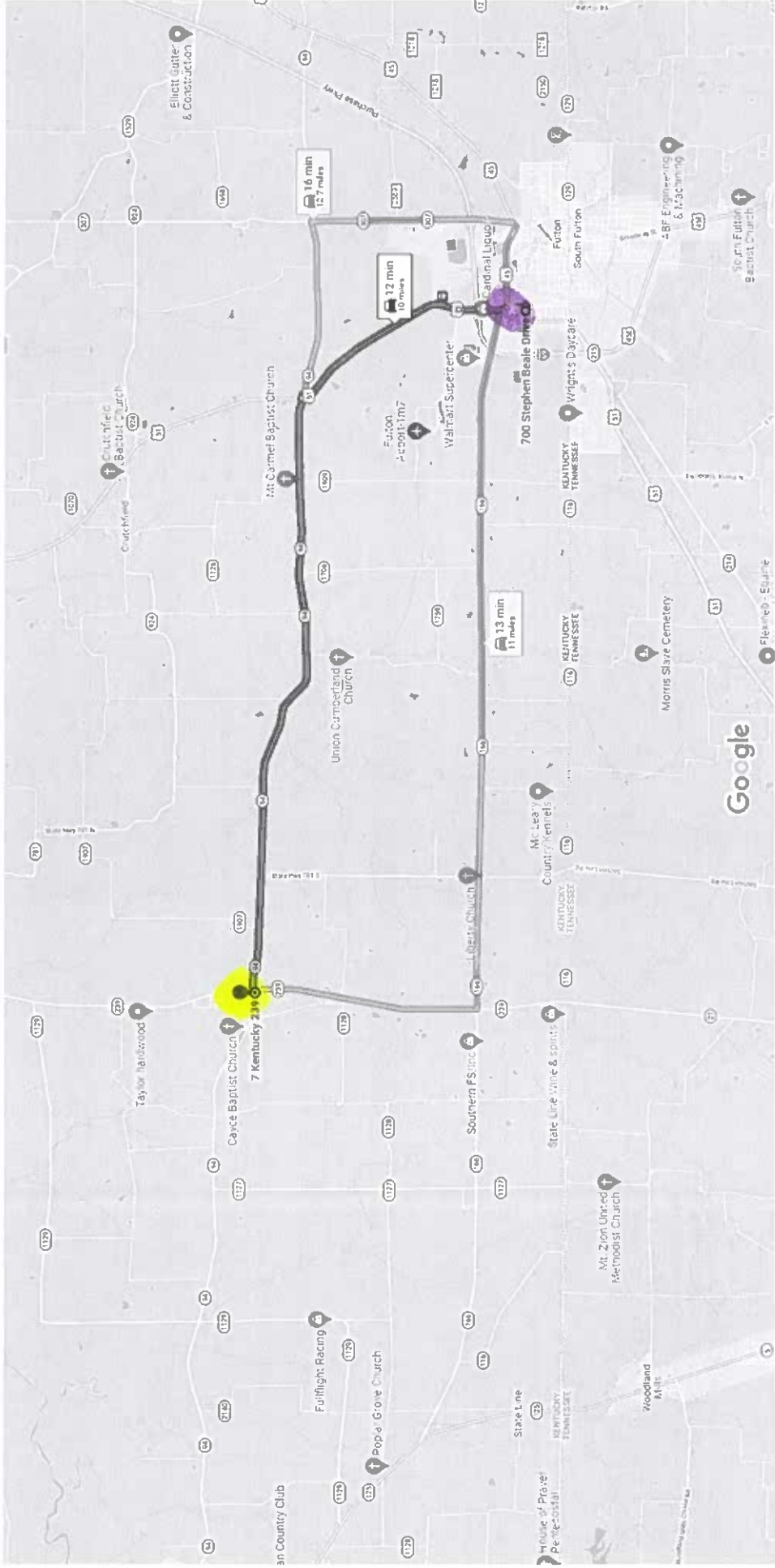

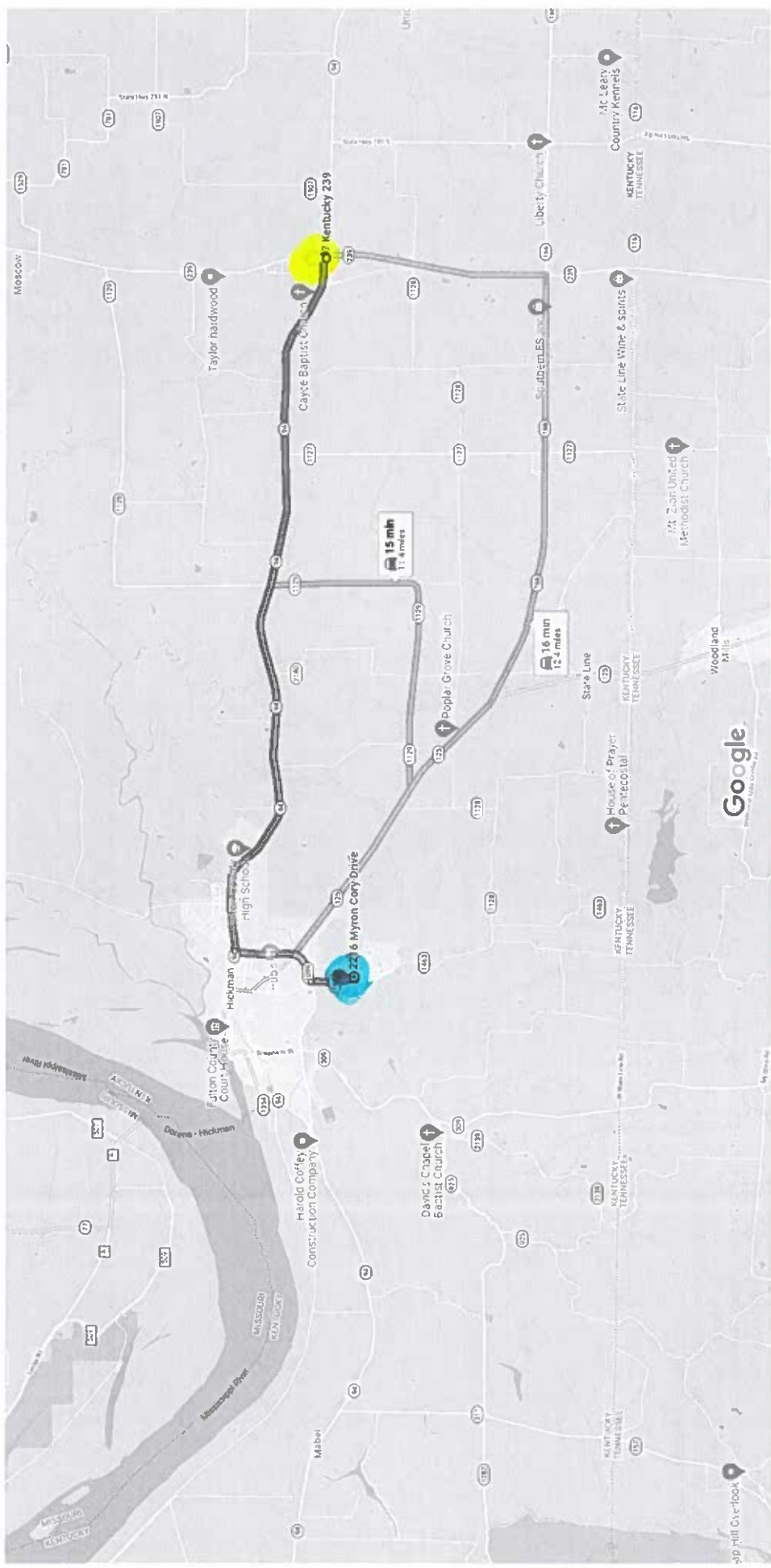

Fulton County Election Plan Proposal

During all previous elections, for the last 10 years, Fulton County has had 11 precincts. These 11 precincts have been split into 3 polling locations. ONE location in Hickman City which housed 5 polling precincts, ONE location in the Cayce Community which housed 2 polling precincts, and ONE location in Fulton City which housed 4 polling precincts. All spread across the County.

During the pandemic Fulton County utilized the same THREE locations, but offered each location to be a VOTE CENTER, allowing any voter access to a ballot at any location. This allowed reduced number of poll workers, and reduced risk to voters of contracting the virus.

The 2022 election plan will be the same as the pandemic plan. Fulton County will utilize THREE locations throughout the County, this will allow any voter to vote at any location. This will reduce confusion to the voter, as to which precinct they MUST go vote in, as well as reduce errors from poll works in sending someone to the incorrect precinct. This plan will also save tax payer dollars by using less equipment and reduced number of poll workers. As you will see in the maps presented, all 3 locations are within 10 miles of each other, and the furthest a voter would travel will be average of 10 miles. There is one exception, and that is Madrid Bend voters. As you will recall, Madrid Bend is only accessible by traveling through Tennessee, which makes this drive a bit longer for these voters. It is not cost effective, nor is there a location in the Bend to allow for a voting location to be stationed. This has been the case since before I came to work in the Clerk's Office in 2007. There are currently 9 voters registered in the Bend. Some of them vote by mail absentee, as they are shut-ins. Others make the drive, usually on Election Day to cast their vote.

Voting Locations:

Hickman Location: This location will house 3 scanning machines, 1 Duo standalone machine, and 1 print bundle. This location will have voters mainly from RECC, Sr. Citizens, Courthouse, Stateline and BWM Watson precincts, totaling a maximum of 2035 voters if every voter from each precinct should vote on Election Day. We know this is highly unlikely, but the amount of equipment can easily handle the load of 2035 voters. This location will be able to vote at least 20-30 voters at any given moment.

Cayce Location: This location will house 2 scanning machines and 1 duo standalone machine. This location will have voters mainly from P-C-J and Cayce precincts, totaling a maximum of 766 voters if every voter from each precinct should vote on Election Day. We know this is highly unlikely, but the amount of equipment can easily handle the load of 766 voters. This location will be able to vote 8-10 voters at any given time.

Fulton Location: This location will house 3 scanning machines, 1 Duo standalone machine. This location will have voters mainly from City Hall, Woman's Club, High School and Police Station precincts, totaling a maximum of 2007 voters if every voter from each precinct should vote on Election Day. We know this is highly unlikely, but the amount of equipment can easily

handle the load of 2007 voters. This location will be able to vote at least 20-30 voters at any given moment.

Each location will have a few voters from other precincts voting, but not enough to make a difference as to how the equipment will work nor how efficiently the poll workers will be able to process these voters.

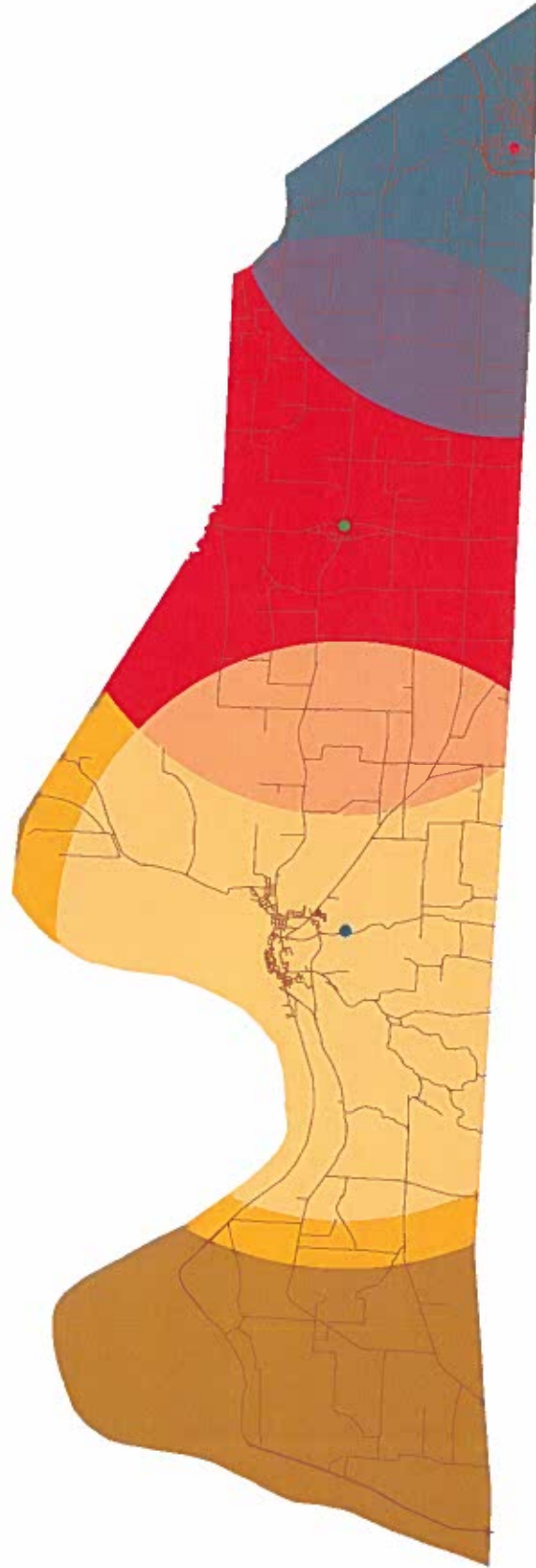
Precinct Officer's will be assigned as Sheriff, Judge or Clerk, and there will be one additional election worker to help sanitize and fill in where needed throughout the day.

All locations are located in areas with adequate lighting and handicap accessibility to accommodate all voters. These locations are well marked and have disabled parking separate for voters who need to use those spaces. These locations are located within a few miles of most voters home, making it a very short distance to travel for those who may have difficulties with transportation. These locations being vote centers allow for those who work away from their home precinct, to vote in the City they work, allowing them easy access to the poll on breaks or the drive to and from work.

All locations will have sanitation stations as well as PPE for any voter whom wishes to use it.

Again, I would stress these locations are the same locations previously used, we just want to make them Vote Centers vs precinct specific locations.
