The Garrard County Election Commission has voted to have 6 voting locations in Garrard County for the May and November 2022 Elections.

Garrard County will provide 3 Voting Centers for ANY Garrard County voter.

The locations will be:

Garrard County Middle School, located in the center of Lancaster.

Paint Lick Elementary located off of Highway 52.

Camp Dick Elementary located off of Highway 27.

85% of Garrard County Residents work out of County. The Board decided having 3 voting centers off of major roadways in Garrard County would benefit voters the most.

Garrard County will provide 3 Precinct locations for voters only in that Precinct.

Being a rural community the board decided distance to a vote center could affect turnout in some areas in our County. Therefore, it was voted on by the board to provided 3 Precincts.

### 3 OPTIONS TO VOTE:

#### MAIL-IN VOTING:

To request a ballot, registered voters should go online to [GOVOTEKY.COM](http://GOVOTEKY.COM)

Ballots must be received either by mail or dropped off in ballot box at the Clerk's Office by 6 pm on the day of the Election.

#### EARLY VOTING:

Any voter may come to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Garrard County Courthouse located at 15 Public Square and vote early for 3 days. May 12, 13 and 14<sup>th</sup> will be the days for early voting.

#### IN PERSON VOTING:

Six voting locations will be provided on Election Day May 17, 2022:

3 Voting Centers for any Garrard County Voter.

3 Voting Precincts Locations (Voters for ONLY those in the Precinct)
