The Hancock County Board of Elections has decided to keep all 10 precincts open for the 2022 primary election with the following changes:

A101 West Lewisport

A102 East Lewisport

The board of elections would like to operate both of these precincts at the same location as a Vote Center. Both precincts are within ½ mile of each other. The West Lewisport precinct is located at the fire station which is a small facility. The East Lewisport precinct is located at the Lewisport community center which is large enough for both precincts to set up and allow the voters to be socially distant from one another. Utilizing this as a vote center, will allow us to cut down from eight election officers to six.

The board of elections would like to operate these 3 precincts as county wide vote centers. All 3 of these precincts are centrally located in schools. Each school is located on a major highway which would allow voters that have to travel outside of their precinct on election day more opportunities to vote. Each one of these precincts were used as county wide vote centers in the 2020 election, so the voters are accustomed to this.

The board of elections would to operate both of these precincts at the same location as a Vote Center. Both precincts are within ½ mile of each other. The West Hawesville precinct is located at the Hawesville Baptist Church New Life Center. The East Hawesville precinct is located at the Immaculate Conception Church Hall. Both precincts are large enough to set up and allow the voters to be socially distant from one another. The board is in agreement that the Hawesville Baptist New Life Center is the best choice because it has better parking and disability accessibility. This will also allow us to cut down from eight election officers to six.

The board of elections would like to operate all three of these precincts as individual precincts. This is a rural area and voters would have to travel distances of over 15 miles if we were to consolidate these precincts. This district has a contested Magistrate race, so the board believes that voter turnout would be greater by keeping these precincts open.

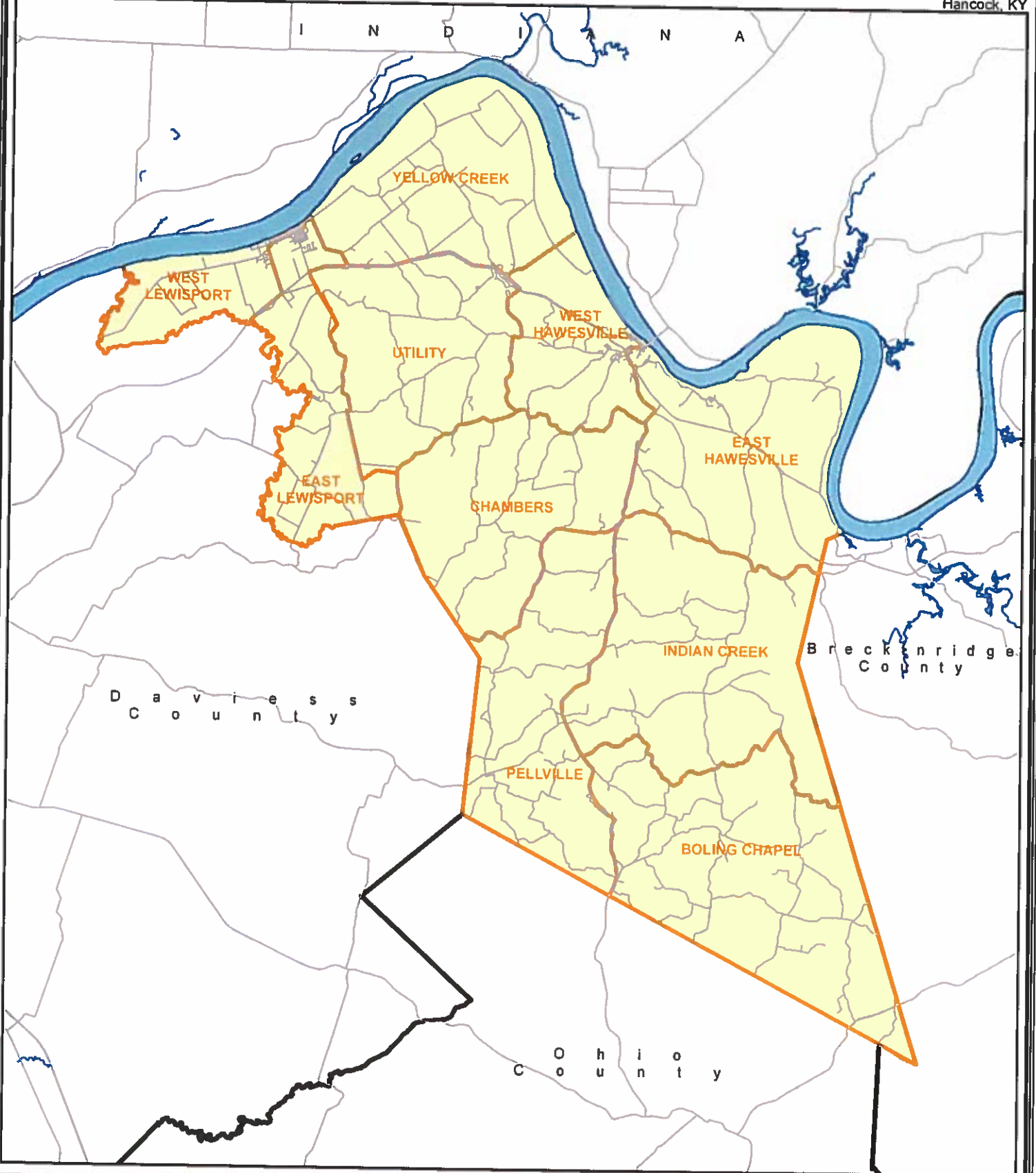
