Hardin County Voting Plan Narrative

(Data from 4/15/2021 SBE Voter Registration Statistics)

Hardin County, the fourth-largest county by area in Kentucky, has a total of 630 square miles, 91,026 registered voters assigned to 59 precincts throughout the county. The majority of highways serving the county to link towns and the population run in a north-south traffic pattern. Four-lane highways running north to south include I-65, US31W (Dixie Hwy.,) WK Parkway and KY Hwy. 1600 (Patriots Pkwy.) East-west 4 lane highways include Joe Prather in the Radcliff area extending to Vine Grove, Lincoln Parkway in the Elizabethtown area extending to the LaRue County line towards Hodgenville and the US31W By-Pass and Ring Road inside the Elizabethtown City Limits. US62, KY Hwy. 251 (Shepherdsville Road/North Miles Streets) and KY Hwy 1357 (Saint John Road) inside the city limits of Elizabethtown are all 4 lane highways. The majority of the population of the county lies along the US31W/I-65 corridor and served by the 4 lane road system.

The Hardin County Board of Elections has identified the location of all 59 precincts on a map of the county secured from 911 services and drew a 10 mile radius around the 7 countywide voting center polling sites they propose to serve the voters in the county during the 2022 election cycle. They identified the precincts most-likely to appear to vote in person on election-day at a countywide voting center based on time and distance (voter convenience) and discussed the total number of registered voters in that area (needed equipment and personnel for expedient, three-minute vote time for the individual. The data reviewed, per countywide voting center follows:

- 1.) Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable?
- ☐ This is the same plan used in the last election

This allows registered voters to use a voting location in the county based on convenience to the time of day/travel requirements applicable to self when casting their bollet.

- 2.) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?
- ☑ This location will be fully staffed with election officials
- Il Domocrats and Il Republicans will staff the polling site with a Judges of both parties, 7 clerks (3 e-pollbooks /3 pulling ballots) each party and I sheriff from each party. The Democrat and Republican Commissioners on the County Board of Elections will appoint the election workers.
