SCHOOLS AND GOV. BLDG ARE FULLY ADA COMPLIANT. PROVIDES ALL REQUIREMENTS SUCH AS RESTROOMS, PHONES, INTERNET ACCESS FOR THE POLL BOOKS. THE SCHOOLS HAVE AMPLE PARKING AND VOTERS HAVE SPACE INSIDE FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING IN THE EVENT OF A LARGE VOTER TURNOUT. THIS ALSO ALLOWS THE VOTER TO BE INSIDE OUT OF THE WEATHER AT ALL TIME DURING VOTING.

JOHNSON COUNTY 2023 PRIMARY ELECTION PLAN

JOHNSON COUNTY'S ELECTION PLAN FOR THE MAY 16, 2023, PRIMARY ELECTION IS THE SAME AS THE GENERAL 2022 PLAN WITH ONE EXCEPTION. THERE WILL BE A POLLING LOCATION AT PAINTSVILLE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL THAT WILL BE A VOTE CENTER WITH THREE VOTING MACHINES. THIS PLAN SPACES THE POLLING LOCATIONS OUT GEOGRAPHICALLY SO THAT VOTERS WILL BE COVERED IN ALL AREAS OF THE COUNTY, THIS PLAN USING VOTE CENTERS HAS WORKED WELL IN THE PASSED ELECTIONS.

SCHOOLS AND GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS ARE GOOD CHOICES FOR MANY REASONS. THERE ARE NO COST TO THE FISCAL COURT FOR RENTAL OF THE FACILITY. THERE IS ACCESS TO HIGH SPEED INTERNET FOR THE USE OF THE POLL BOOKS. PARKING IS AMPLE AND VOTERS HAVE THE PROPER HANDICAP ACCESSIBILITY. THE POLLING LOCATIONS PROVIDED LARGER AREAS FOR THE VOTERS TO BE ABLE TO SOCIAL DISTANCE AND BE INSIDE OUT OF THE WEATHER.

HAVING VOTE CENTERS ARE WELL RECEIVED BY THE VOTERS AND THEY LIKE BEING ABLE TO GO TO ANY POLLING LOCATION AND BE ABLE TO VOTE. THIS CUTS DOWN ON THE NUMBER OF ELECTION OFFICERS NEEDED AND ALLOWS FOR MORE EXTENSIVE TRAINING OF THE OFFICERS. THE VOTING EQUIPMENT THAT WAS PURCHASED FOR JOHNSON COUNTY DOES NOT ALLOW FOR ALL 31 PRECINCTS AND THE PURCHASE OF ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT HAS NOT BEEN APPROVED BY THE FISCAL COURT.

HAVING LIMITED EARLY VOTING WAS A CHALLENGE. I MADE EVERY EFFORT TO INFORM VOTERS OF THE TIMES AND LOCATIONS TO BE ABLE TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF EARLY VOTING. I HAD GREAT COOPERATION FROM THE LOCAL RADIO, NEWSPAPER, FACEBOOK, AND THE COUNTY'S WEBSITE GETTING THE INFORMATION OUT TO VOTERS. THIS HELPS ELEVATE THE CROWDS ON ELECTION DAY.

THE VOTING EQUIPMENT WAS PURCHASED BY HUNDREDS OF DOLLARS. ES&S VOTING MACHINES AND DS200 OPTICAL SCAN EQUIPMENT. THE E-POLL BOOKS THAT ARE ALSO ES&S POLL BOOKS THAT ARE BEING PURCHASED BY GRANT MONEY FOR THE PRIMARY. HAVING A SECURE DROP BOX IN THE LOBBY OF THE JOHNSON COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE IS VERY HELPFUL AND IS EXTREMELY SECURE.

THE JOHNSON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS GOAL IS TO ENSURE FAIR AND HONEST ELECTIONS WITH MAKING THE VOTING PROCESS A GOOD EXPERIENCE FOR THE VOTER.
