Dear All,

On behalf of the Kenton County Board of Elections, I have submitted our plan for the 2023 Primary.

Drop Boxes- four (4) drop boxes located in two locations.

Inside and outside at Kenton Co Gov't Center, 1840 Simon Kenton Way, Covington

Inside and outside at Historic Independence Courthouse, 5272 Madison Pike,
Independence

Precincts- 70 precincts with Democrat and Republican ballots for a total of 140 ballot faces. There are no non-partisan races on the ballot.

Early Voting Locations- Five (5) early voting locations that will function as a voting center and allow a voter to go to any location to receive their specific precinct ballot. This is accomplished with using a print on demand system as well as the ES&S Express Vote which is a ballot marker. The Express Vote will have all precinct ballot options loaded on the machine and therefore can be used by any voter to mark their ballot electronically and then print a ballot to be scanned.

Election Day Locations- Thirty-Four (34) Locations will be used for the primary election. We had 24 locations in the 2022 Primary and General Elections. We have increased the number of locations not because of the long lines since Kenton County had one of its lowest turnouts at 36%, but in anticipation of the Presidential Election. If the Board is interested in the statistics on the lines in Kenton County, please let me know.

Precincts will be assigned to a specific location on Election Day where there will be a pre-printed ballot. However, we are programming all of the Express Vote machines and DS200 Scanners to accept all of the 70 precinct ballots. This gives the voters a lot of flexibility in choosing to go to any location that may be more convenient on Election Day. It also ensures that if a voter goes to the wrong location or has moved that we do not have to redirect them to a different physical location. This again is possible due to leaving the Print of Demand systems in place for Election Day as well as the use of the Express Vote ADA ballot markers.

The only caveat to increasing the number of locations is that Kenton County Board of Elections is now under an agreement with the Department of Justice to ensure each location is ADA complainant. This agreement gives power to the DOJ on which locations can be used for elections. The provided SBE 74 forms are what Kenton County is proposing pending the approval of the DOJ.

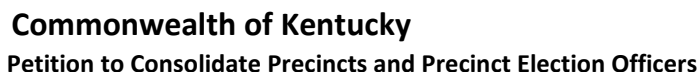
