1.) Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable? These two locations were utilized in both the 2020 Primary and General elections. Voters complimented the voting process as a great improvement, with the option of voting at either location. They also appreciated the large parking lots and large gymnasiums with the threat of COVID. They spoke highly of how smoothly and quickly they entered, voted, and exited. In addition, these locations are both centrally located in the northern and southern parts of Livingston County. Residents are accustomed to driving miles and miles, out of county, for groceries, gas, and employment. The furthest distance a voter will have to drive is approximately 12 miles.

2.) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned? Precinct officers will be contacted whom worked the previous election. Four precinct officers per precinct will be assigned to each location. South will have 24 officers to check-in voters, distribute ballots, and direct voters to scan their ballots and exit. Additional officers will be staffed as well as door greeters.

3.) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a "Vote Center?" Locations will be publicized through our local newspaper, T.V. Station, social media, and possibly postcard mailings.

4.) How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community? Livingston County is a county divided in half by the Cumberland River, literally creating a North and South Livingston. Our county only has a elementary schools which are utilized the majority of the time for community events because they offer a large parking lot with numerous handicap accessible spots and large seating with disabled seating sections along with ramps for entering and exiting. Residents are familiar with the locations and both are centrally located on their respective sides of the river, with the furthest drive being approximately 12 miles.

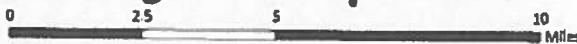
