RE: Marion County Election Plan – 2023 Primary Election

To the Honorable Members of the State Board of Elections:

The Marion County Board of Elections asks that you review our Election Plan for the 2023 Primary Election. Below, we will summarize the plan. Attached, you will find the Petition to Consolidate Precincts and Precinct Election Officers (SBE 74) that we submitted for the 2022 Primary Election for Early Voting and for those locations that will be consolidated.

The only changes to those SBE 74s will be that we plan to use KNOWiNK Poll Pad units instead of Tenex ePoll Books and the number of voters has slightly changed. I am happy to update those forms if you would prefer. I have updated the number of voters on the summary below. I have attached this letter and summary from last year for the sake of comparison.

The Marion County Board of Elections has voted to continue our "Common Sense Consolidation" for some of our Election Day polling locations. We will also be offering the ability for voters to utilize any of the Election Day polling locations within their magisterial districts, creating "Magisterial Vote Centers". In addition to that, we will be offering three days of Early Voting on the Thursday, Friday, and Saturday before Election Day at the David R. Hourigan Government Building.

Below, you will find a list of the polling locations that will be open on Election Day for the 2023 Primary Election and the address for the facility. Attached, you will find a map of Marion County with the polling locations marked, the SBE 74 for Early Voting, and the SBE 74 forms for each of our "Common Sense Consolidations"
