The Mason County Board of Elections met Friday, January 13, 2023, and voted unanimously to use the same election plan as was used for the General Election in November 2022. All of these vote centers have been used since 2020 and are located in the northern, eastern, southern, and western parts of the county and along main highways that are heavily traveled by voters. Lastly, the repetition of using the same vote centers consistently for each election minimizes voter confusion as to locations.
