Enclosed you will find five (5) SBE 74 forms detailing my election plan for five centers in Mason County for the Primary Election on May 17, 2022. The county board of elections chose these locations for a variety of reasons. First, four of them were used in 2020 for some aspect of early voting and were well received by voters. Also, there is at least one vote center in each county commissioner district. Lastly, the vote centers are located in the northern, eastern, southern and western parts of the county along main highways that are heavily traveled by voters. Our goal as the county board of elections was to choose elections along these routes, making it easy for voters to access the vote centers. Maps are also enclosed for you to view.

The three-day period of early voting will take place in the Mason County Clerk's Office. In 2020, early voting was held at another location but due to only having one race in the Primary Election and the expected low turnout as a result, the decision was made to have early voting in the clerk's office. This will be advertised in the same manner as the vote centers.

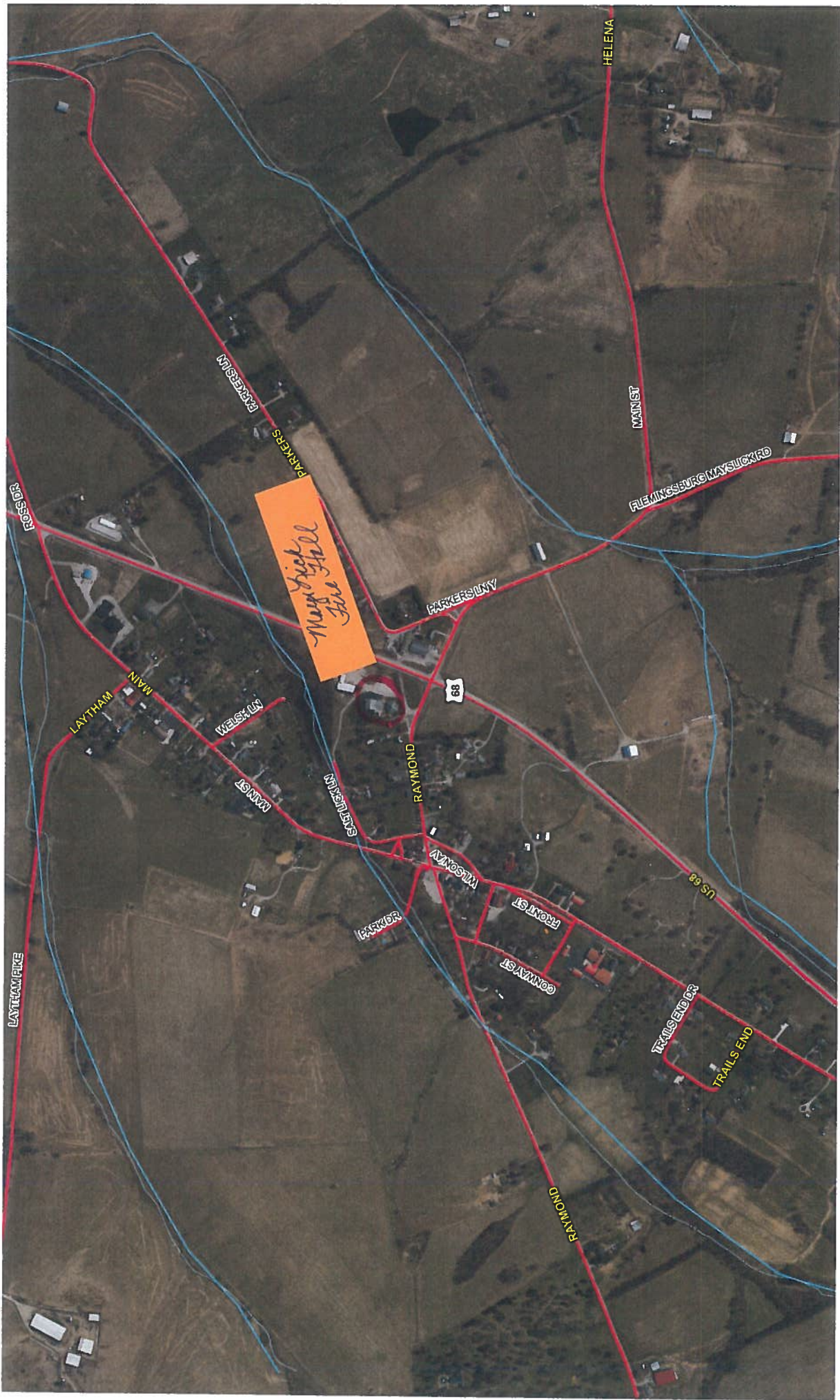

The Fieldhouse was used as a vote center in 2020 and was well- liked by voters for its ease of access. The Fieldhouse location is well-known among voters, is the largest building used as a polling place in Mason County and has multiple levels for parking.

Like the election in 2020, I will have several clerks to check in voters, several judges to distribute ballots and monitor the election equipment, as well as a sheriff to maintain order in the vote center. I would estimate having 8 poll workers at this location.

The vote center will be publicized through the newspaper, radio, tv ads and social media.
<b>4.) How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community?</b>
The Fieldhouse is located along US 68, which is heavily traveled during the day, as it stands among retail stores, restaurants, banks and schools. The centrality of the location will serve voters well, not only those who live and work near the vote center, but also those traveling to town on errands.
