1) Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable?

This proposed consolidation of precincts is the exact plan Woodford County utilized for the elections in 2020 and 2022. The entire process of having a voting center at Falling Springs Recreation Center was well received by the voters in both elections in 2020 and 2022 who voted in person at this one location on election day. Based on there being absolutely no problems with long lines that would affect the efficiency and speed of their voting experience, the replication of the clearly defined plan that was used in previous elections at the Falling Springs Voting Center, which is centrally located in the middle of the county, is respectfully requested for consideration.

The Woodford County Board of Elections received a huge amount of positive feedback from voters on Election Day while voting at Falling Springs Recreation Center and weeks after the election. The plan for In-Person Voting for this facility that has 3 basketball courts, is to only use one court that will provide 4 voting machines and 30 voting booths. With 4 clerks available to sign in voters on the E-Poll Book at each station with a 45 second to 1 minute check in time, any delay to move a voter through to receive their ballot and cast their vote would be minimal to none.

2) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?

With 4 stations available, there will be a Clerk, a Democratic Judge, and a Republican Judge at each station. There is no need to have a Sheriff assigned to each station; however, there will be 2 Sheriffs assigned to oversee the needs all 4 stations.

3) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a “Vote Center?”

First and foremost, all Precinct Election Officers who witnessed the positive voting experience at the “Falling Springs Voting Center” while serving during the 2020 and 2022 elections would be the best form of publicity. They would not only be announcing the location, but they would be able to express as a first-hand witness how the voting process was efficient at Falling Springs and the parking was not an issue due to having a golf cart move voters to and from their parking space to the front door. Of course, the normal forms of advertising would be used such as our local newspaper, social media, and signage. This location would be noted as the “Falling Springs Voting Center.”

4) How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community??

The Falling Springs Recreation Center is the focal point of our entire community. If you are familiar with the center and the County Park here in Woodford County, you know this facility is used by all ages with the theater, pools, basketball courts, fitness center, numerous ball fields, soccer stadium/football stadium, fairgrounds, etc.

The location of this center, which serves as the pivotal, essential hub of our community, is located in the center of the county as evidenced by the map attached. As shown on Attachment A, a Voting Center at the Falling Springs Recreation Center is more than reasonably accessible to all voters and can allow 90 voters to vote at one time.

1) Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable?

This proposed consolidation of precincts is the plan Woodford County utilized for the elections in 2020 and 2022 at the voting center located at the Falling Springs Recreation Center. The previous plan has now been expanded to include 4 more stations, which is comparable to 4 precincts, that will be located in the third basketball court of the Falling Springs Voting Center.

The entire process of having a voting center at Falling Springs Recreation Center was well received by the voters who voted in person in both elections in 2020 and 2022 at this one location on election day. Based on there being absolutely no problem with long lines that would affect the efficiency and speed of their voting experience, the replication of the clearly defined plan that was used in previous elections at the Falling Springs Voting Center, which is centrally located in the center of the county, is respectfully requested for consideration.

The Woodford County Board of Elections received a huge amount of positive feedback from voters on Election Day while voting at Falling Springs Recreation Center and weeks after the election. This voting center has 3 basketball courts and a multi-purpose room that provides 14 voting machines and 90 voting booths. With 13 clerks available to sign in voters on the E-Poll Book at each station, with a 45 second to 1 minute check-in time, any delay to move a voter through to receive their ballot and cast their vote would be minimal to none.

The size of the parking lot at this voting center will accommodate the largest number of participants, by design, due to the many activities, i.e., sporting events, theater attendance, etc. that are held there daily. As in previous elections, there will be golfcarts available on the lot to pick up voters from their cars and deliver them to the door of the voting center and back to their car after they have voted. Additionally, we have a wheelchair ready and accessible for any voter with mobility problems that needs assistance getting from the curbside handicap parking space to the front door.

2) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?

With 13 stations available, there will be a Clerk, a Democratic Judge, and a Republican Judge at each station. There is no need to have a Sheriff assigned to each station; however, there will be one Sheriff assigned to oversee the needs of each basketball court and the multi-purpose room. By using this order of assignment, there would be a reduction of 9 Sheriffs assigned as Precinct Election Officers, creating a savings to the fiscal court.

3) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a “Vote Center?”

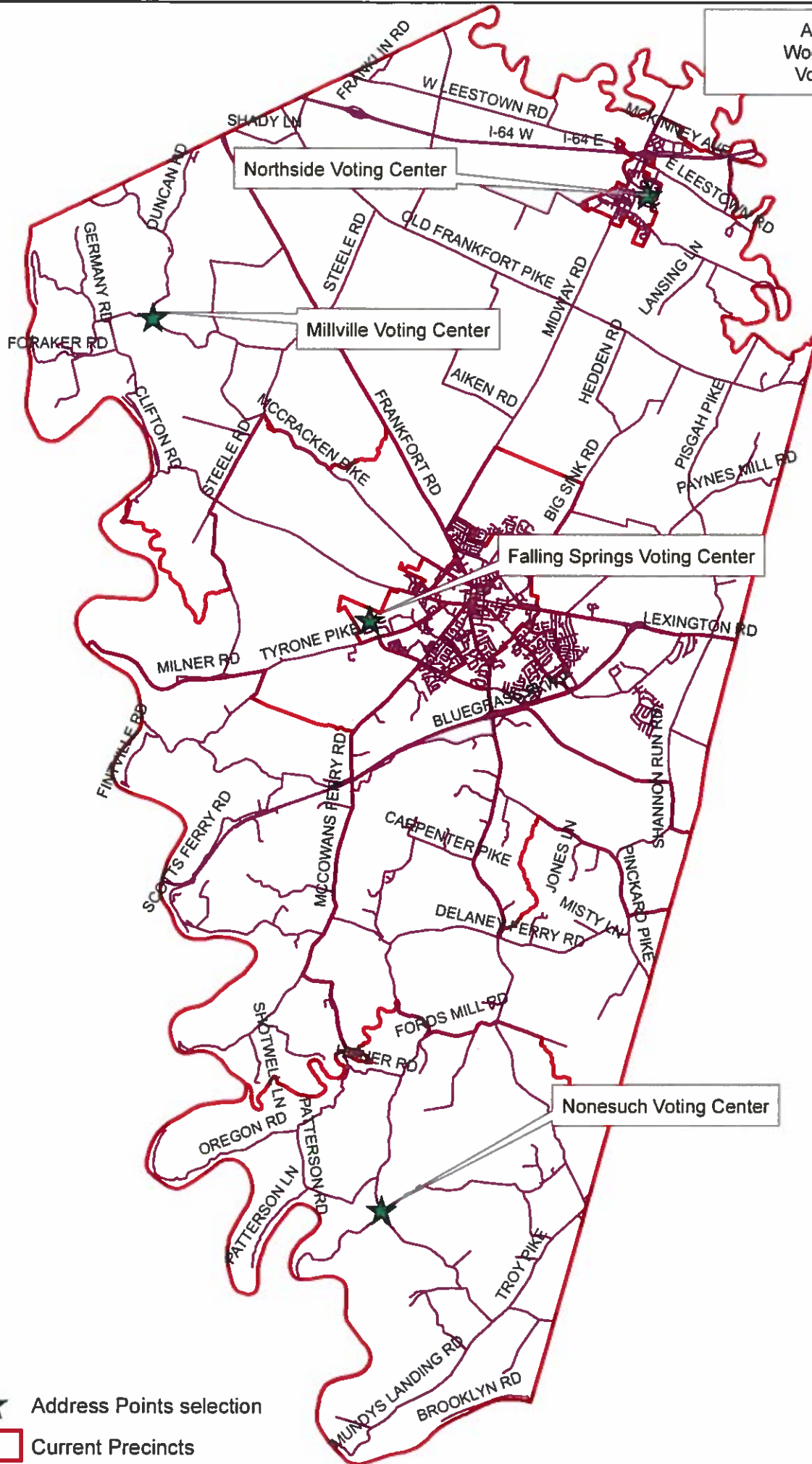

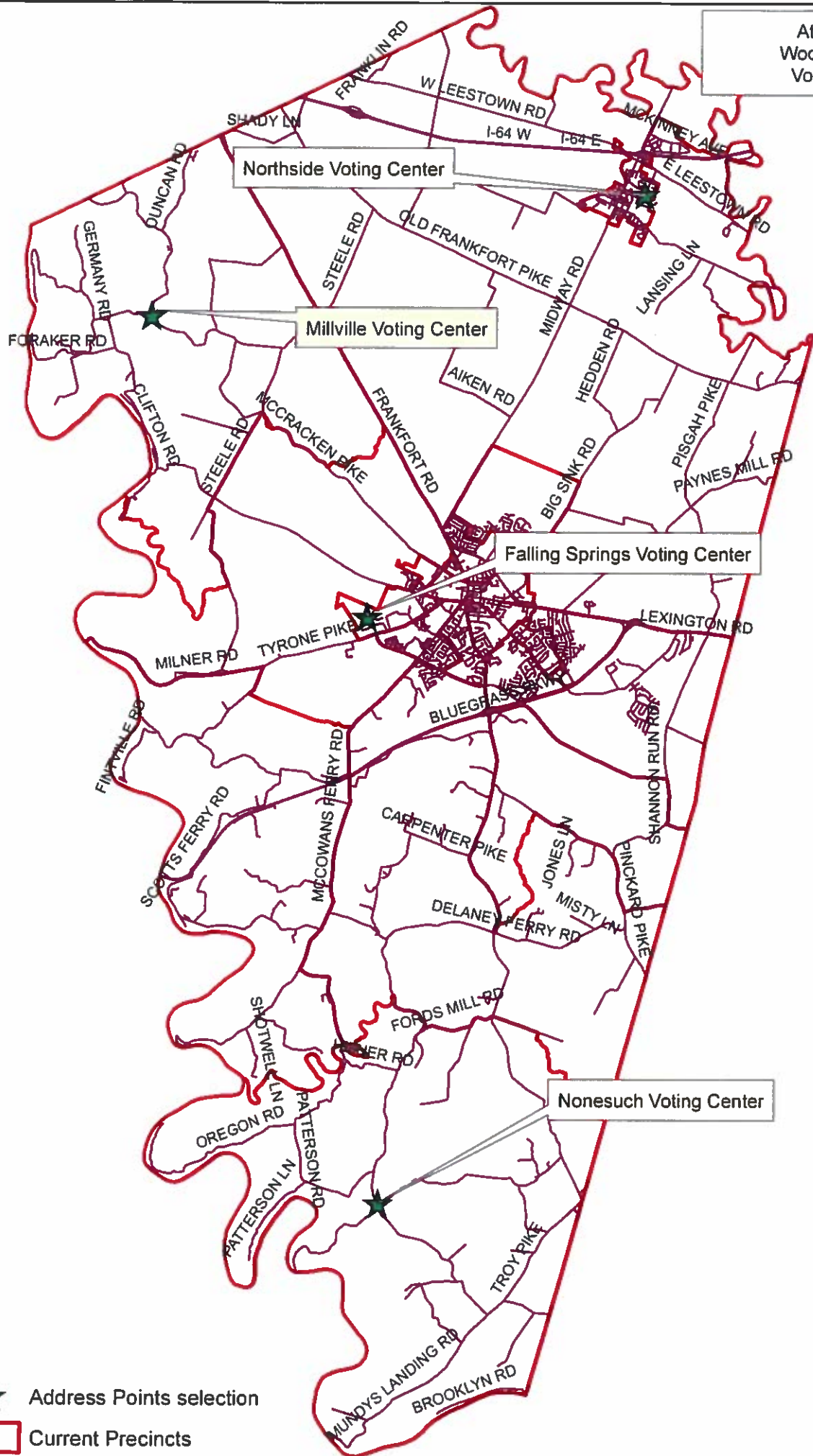
3) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a “Vote Center?”

With 1 station available, there will be a Clerk, a Democratic Judge, a Republican Judge and a Sheriff at the 1 station.

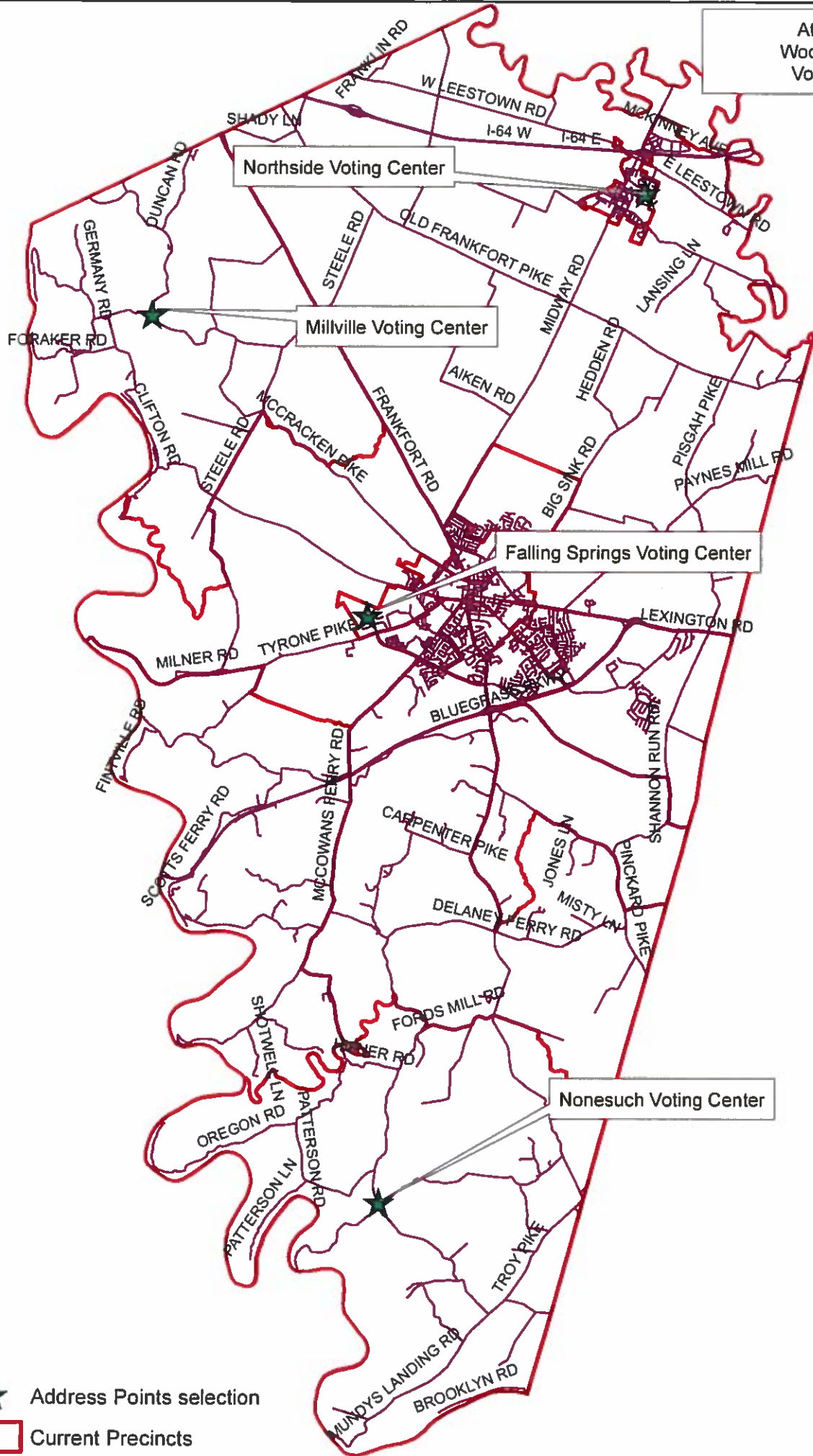
3) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a “Vote Center?”

With 1 station available, there will be a Clerk, a Democratic Judge, a Republican Judge and a Sheriff at the 1 station.

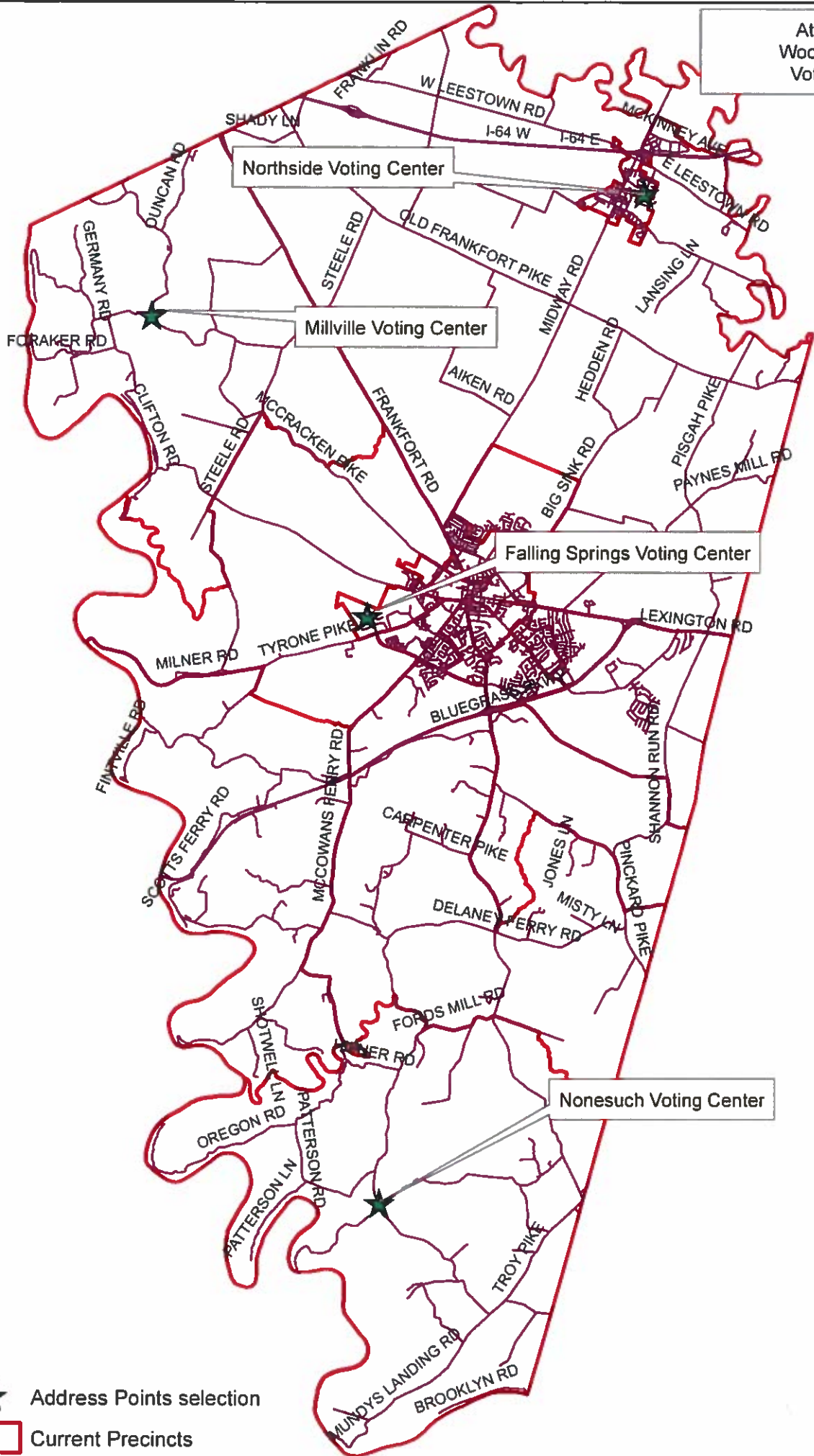
3) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a “Vote Center?”
