**1) Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable?**

This proposed consolidation of precincts for the purpose of having an In-Person Voting Center is the exact plan Woodford County utilized for the elections in 2020. The entire process of having early voting 18 days prior to the General Election of 2020 at the courthouse outside the office of the Woodford County Clerk was well received by the voters. This location provided adequate space between voters during ingress and egress, during the time a voter was being checked in by the clerks to receive their ballot, the actual casting of their vote, and scanning in their ballot. The choice made by a voter to vote in person was safe and all precautions were taken in order to not jeopardize a voter's health. Based on there being absolutely no problems with safety of the voters or the efficiency and speed of their voting experience, the replication of the clearly defined plan that was used previously at the courthouse for In-Person Voting is respectfully requested for consideration.

**2) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?**

With 2 stations available, there will be a Clerk, a Democratic Judge, and a Republican Judge at each station. There is no need to have a Sheriff assigned to each station; however, there will be one Sheriff assigned to oversee the needs of this in-person voting center.

**3) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a "Vote Center?"**

The In-Person Voting Center will be publicized to the voters by the normal forms of advertising such as our local newspaper, social media, and signage. This location would be noted as we previously referred to In-Person Voting Center located at the Woodford County Courthouse.

**4) How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community??**

The voting location of the In-Person Vote Center will be at the Woodford County Courthouse, in the hallway outside the office of the Woodford County Clerk, using the same logistics as practiced during both the Primary and General Elections of 2020. As proven during the previous elections, the safety and efficiency only enhanced the fact that the courthouse is one of the most central points of the county, which serves as a focal point that meets the needs of a diverse community.

**1) Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable?**

This proposed consolidation of precincts is the exact plan Woodford County utilized for the elections in 2020. The entire process of having a voting center at Falling Springs Recreation Center was well received by the voters who voted in person at this one location on Election Day. This location provided adequate space between voters during ingress and egress, during the time a voter was being checked in by the clerks to receive their ballot, the actual casting of their vote, and scanning in their ballot. The choice made by a voter to vote in person was safe and all precautions were taken in order to not jeopardize a voter's health. Based on there being absolutely no problems with safety of the voters or the efficiency and speed of their voting experience, the replication of the clearly defined plan that was used previously is respectfully requested for consideration.

The Woodford County Board of Elections received a huge amount of positive feedback from voters on Election Day while voting at Falling Springs Recreation Center and weeks after the Election. This facility has 3 basketball courts and a multi-purpose room that will provide 16 voting machines and 76 voting booths. With 13 clerks available to sign in voters on the E-Poll Book at each station, any delay to move a voter through to receive their ballot and cast their vote would be minimal to none.

**2) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?**

With 8 stations available, there will be a Clerk, a Democratic Judge, and a Republican Judge at each station. There is no need to have a Sheriff assigned to each station; however, there will be one Sheriff assigned to oversee the needs of each basketball court and the multi-purpose room. By using this order of assignment, there would be a reduction of 9 Sheriffs assigned as Precinct Officers, creating a savings to the fiscal court.

**3) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a "Vote Center?"**

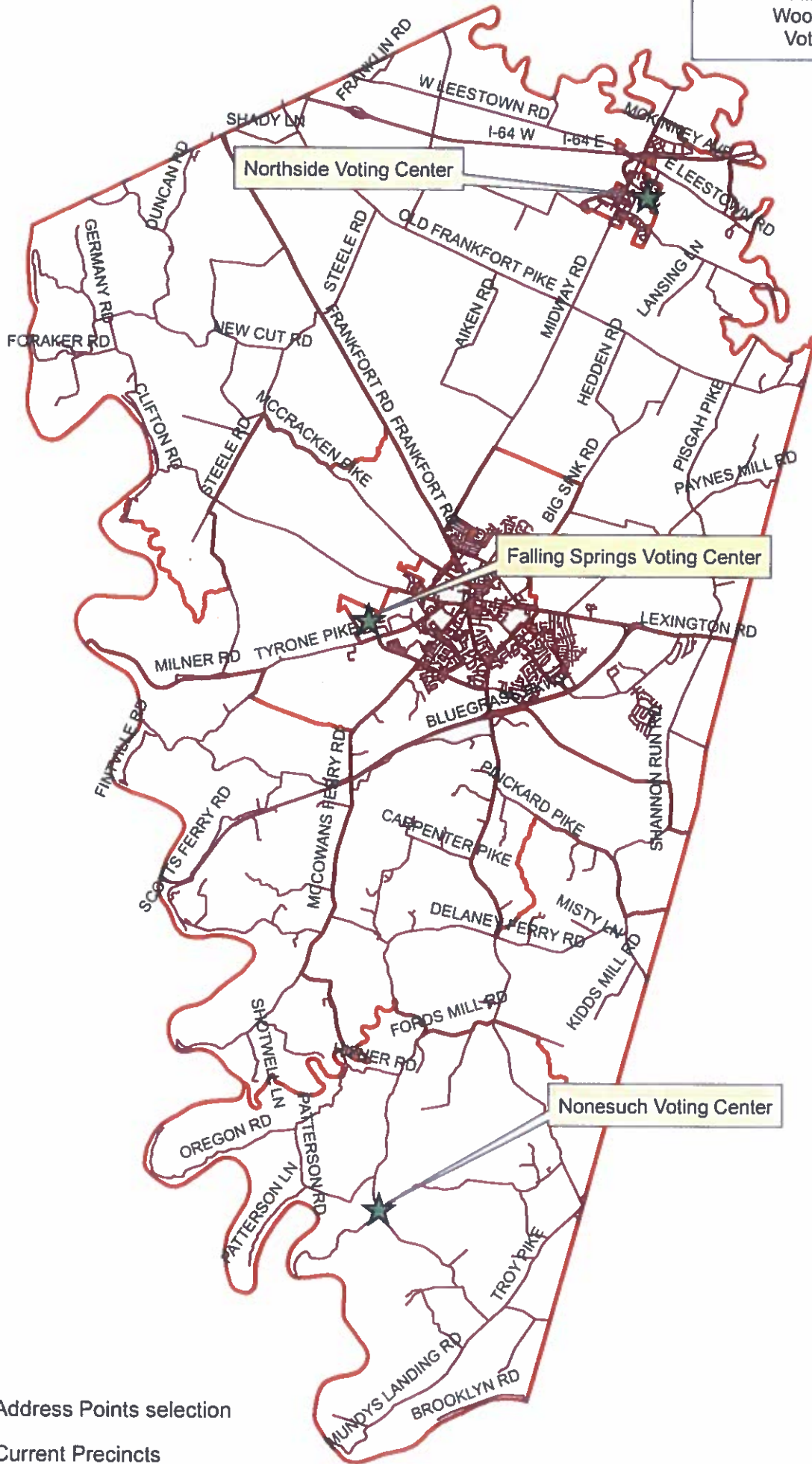
First and foremost, all Precinct Officers who witnessed the positive voting experience at the "Vote Center" while serving during the 2020 elections would be the best form of publicity. They would not only be announcing the location, but they would be able to express as a first-hand witness how the voting process was efficient at Falling Springs and the parking was not an issue due to having a golf cart move voters to and from their parking space to the front door. Of course, the normal forms of advertising would be used such as our local newspaper, social media, and signage. This location would be noted as the "**Falling Springs Voting Center.**"

4) **How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community??**

The Falling Springs Recreation Center is the focal point of our entire community. If you are familiar with the center and the County Park here in Woodford County, you know this facility is used by all ages with the theater, pools, basketball courts, fitness center, numerous ball fields, soccer stadium/football stadium, fairgrounds, etc.

The location of this center, which serves as the pivotal, essential hub of our community, is located in the center of the county as evidenced by the map attached. As shown on Attachment A, a Vote Center at the Falling Springs Recreation Center is reasonably accessible to all voters.

This proposed consolidation of precincts located at Northside Elementary School could easily be utilized for the elections in 2022. This location provides adequate space to have 2 clerk check-in stations, approximately 30-35 voting booths, 2 Verity Voting Machines, and 1 Verity Duo Voting Machine.

The residents of the City of Midway would appreciate the voting center being approved in Midway not only for the convenience of voting, but also for the fact this would validate the fact Midway is a separate 1<sup>st</sup> Class City that is worthy of being awarded its own voting center.

**2) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?**

With 2 stations available, there will be a Clerk, a Democratic Judge, and a Republican Judge at each station. There is no need to have a Sheriff assigned to each station; however, there will be 3 Sheriffs assigned to oversee the needs of the voters.

**3) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a “Vote Center?”**

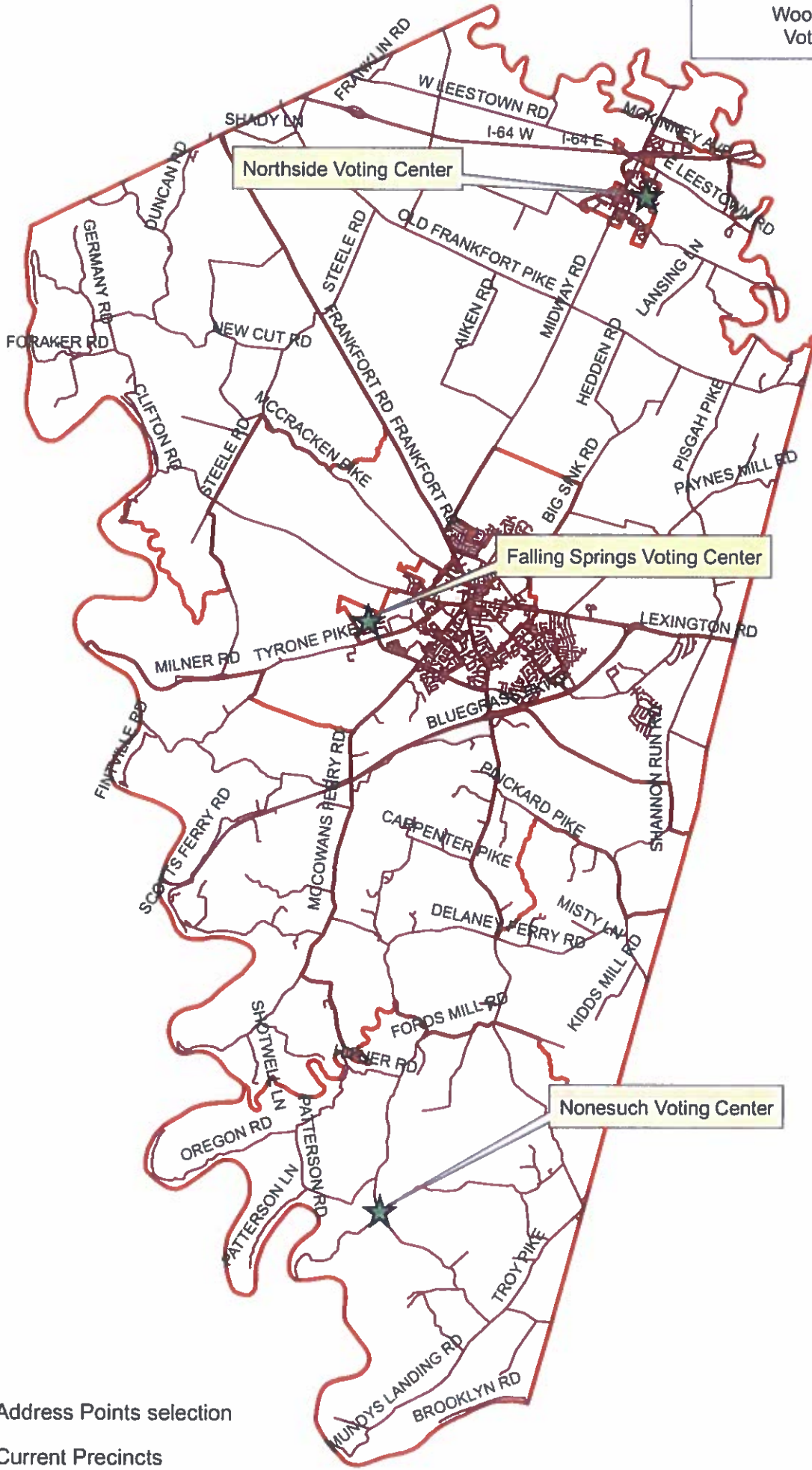
The normal forms of advertising would be used such as our local newspaper, social media, and signage. This location would be referred to as the “Northside Voting Center.”

With 1 stations available, there will be a Clerk, a Democratic Judge, a Republican Judge and a Sheriff at the 1 station. .

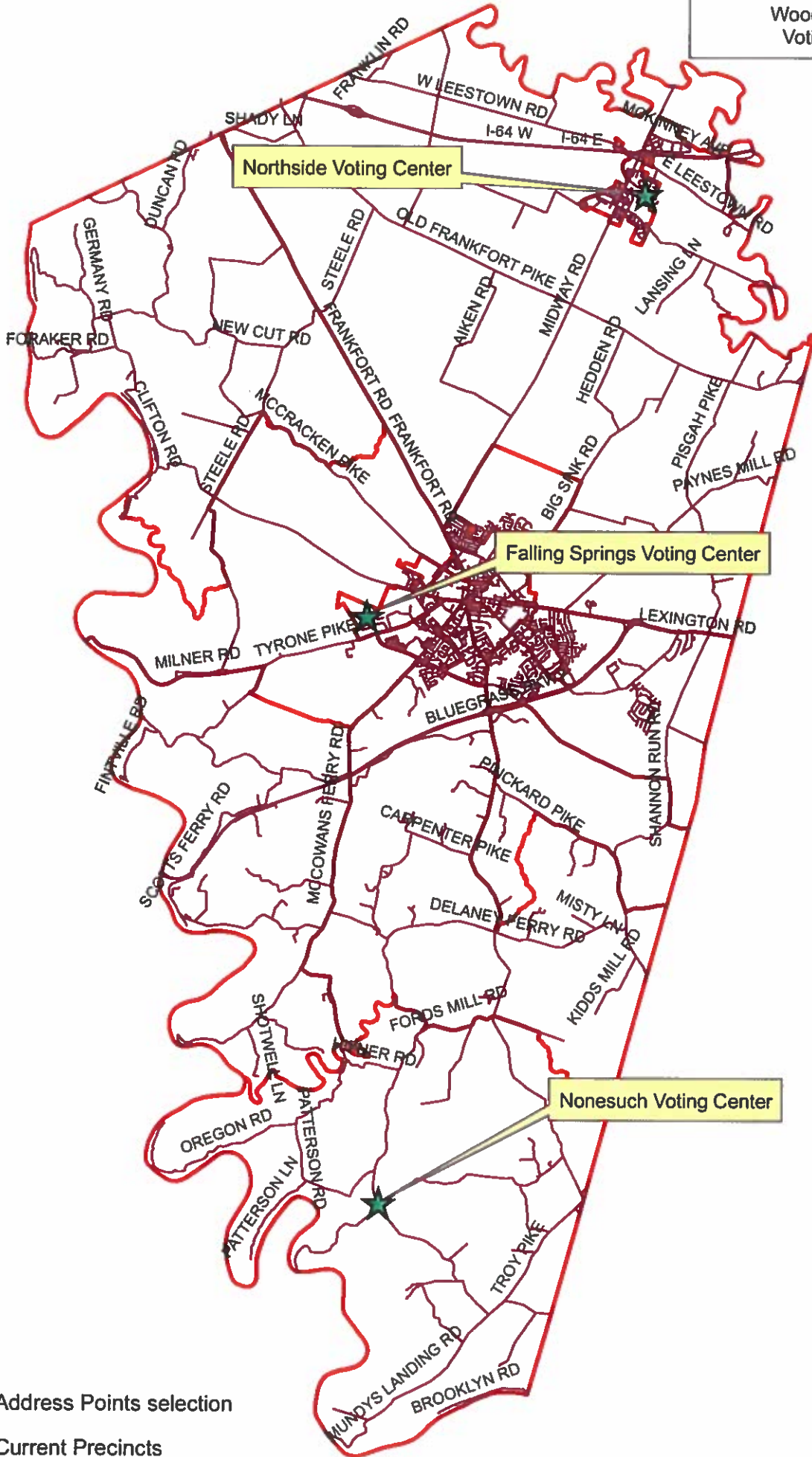
**3) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a “Vote Center?”**
