8. Early Voting (no excuse 3 day): Early voting will be held at the County Judge Executive's office at 201 S 4<sup>th</sup> St Murray, KY 42071. This area was utilized in the 2020, 2022 and 2023 Election cycle and was well received.

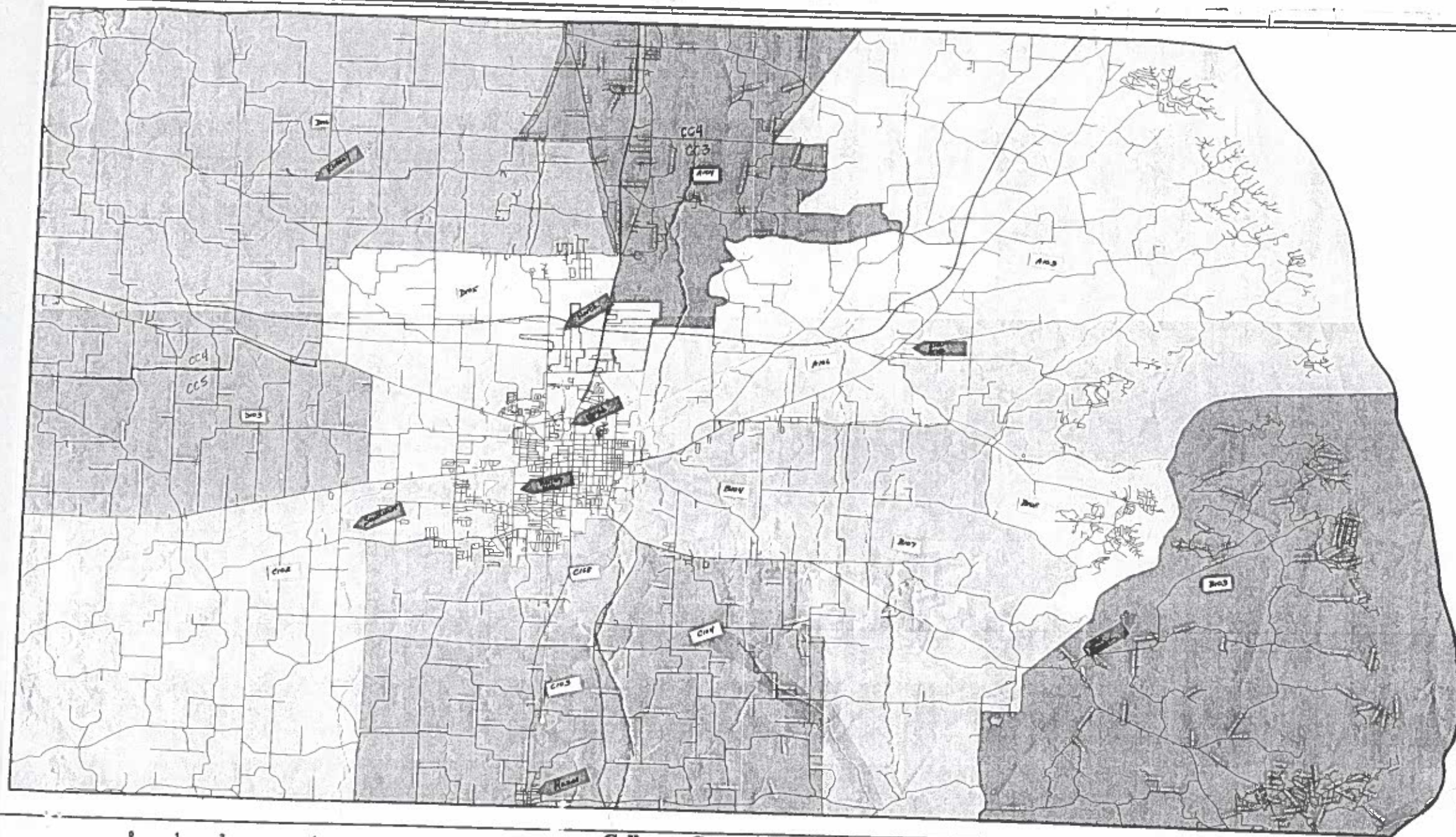
